Bethany Bison

In their only match of the week, the Bison dominated Pitt-Bradford in a 2-1 victory ... Bethany outshot the Panthers 17-5 in the first half but the game remained scoreless at the break ... Senior **Ramon Franklyn** finally put a score on the board with a brilliant individual effort in the 60th minute ... He dribbled through the UP-B defense from 25 yards out, then struck a shot to the far right post from the left wing for his second score of the season ... Just over a minute later, Franklyn flicked a ball to **Sean Esterbauer** flying down the right wing, who buried a shot for his second goal of the year to double BC's advantage to 2-0 ... The visitors would score off a rebound from a saved PK in the 78th minute ... Bethany ran its unbeaten streak to four ... GK **Kosta Floros** saved four shots in the triumph.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City went 1-1 in a pair of home matches last week ... The Wolverines opened the week with a 2-0 setback against Carnegie Mellon at College Field ... CMU scored twice in the second half to secure the non-conference win ... Junior GK **Michael Manahan** stopped seven shots for Grove City ... CMU owned a 12-7 shot edge ...
