Sophomore forward Beaver Falls, Pa./Blackhawk H.S.

McNees led the Wolverines to a pair of wins last week with three goals and an assist for seven points. He scored twice in Grove City's 3-0 win over Bethany in the PAC opener, after posting a goal and an assist in a 3-0 non-league win at Lake Erie.

Other nominees included freshman GK Ryan Lewis of Thiel, freshman MF Todd Schollaert of Waynesburg, and senior MF Sebastian Driver-Salazar of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S SOCCER NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison lost two games last week and have now lost three consecutive games after starting the season with four straight wins ... The Bison lost to a tough Notre Dame (Ohio) squad at home Wednesday by a 3-1 score ... Bethany freshman Myles McKenzie notched his first career goal ... Later in the week, flooding in the Bethany area forced the scheduled home contest against Grove City to be moved to Grove City ... It was the PAC opener for the Bison, as their match against Thiel earlier in the season was postponed ... The Wolverines won the game, 3-0 ... The scheduled game at Grove City on Sept. 27 has been moved to Bethany ... The Bison have been outscored 7-1 during the three-game losing streak.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson had its losing streak extended to four matches after a pair of road losses at CMU and Penn State-Behrend this past week ... The Tartans rolled out to a 5-0 halftime lead on Wednesday in cruising past the Presidents ... Senior forward Mike Chiodo scored his first goal of the season late in the second half to end the CMU run ... Senior goalkeeper Mike Garet made six saves in 52 minutes of action ... PS-B scored in the final minute of the first half and then again three minutes into the second half to earn the win on Saturday ... Both teams attempted 11 shots and Garet corralled six saves once again.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City picked up a pair of 3-0 victories last week, including a win over PAC rival Bethany Saturday ... Sophomore F Bob McNees scored twice while Nate Jones had a goal and an assist against the Bison ... Peter Williams and Ben Hoffman also had assists while Joel Gladfelter earned the shutout victory ... Hoffman and McNees each had a goal and an assist at Lake Erie Wednesday while Williams also scored ... Jones made his collegiate debut as a goalkeeper at Lake Erie, picking up the shutout victory ... Saturday's match against Bethany, originally scheduled for Bethany, was moved to Grove City due to flooding ... Grove City has scored 10 of its 16 goals this year in the second half of matches.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets, with a 2-1 record last week, hold a winning record (4-3) for the first time since last September ... Freshman MF Todd Schollaert was pivotal in both Jacket wins this week, leading the team with four points ... He netted the lone goal in the Jackets win, 1-0, over Ohio Valley Tuesday ... The shutout of OVC was the first of freshman GK Camillo DiLorenzo's career ... After Waynesburg was shutout by Westminster 5-0 Thursday, it responded with a 3-1 victory over Pitt-Bradford Saturday ... The Jackets trailed much of the game against the Panthers until the last 20 minutes when they evened the score at 1-1 ... Schollaert, along with classmate Michael Wilson and team captain Nick West, claimed goals in the win.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel went 2-0 last week in non-conference action ... Senior MF Evan Knox scored on a penalty kick in the 70th minute to give the Tomcats a 1-0 nonconference victory at Hiram Tuesday ... Knox, scoring his first goal of the season and seventh of his career, buried the penalty kick after freshman F Josh Kwolek was brought down in the Terriers' box ... Freshman GK Ryan Lewis started the game while sophomore Mark Coney took over in the second half to split the shutout ... Freshman F Nikola Vasilev and junior MF John Rossi each had a goal in Thiel's 2-0 shutout victory of Pitt-Bradford Sunday ... Vasilev tallied his team-best fifth goal of the season while Rossi registered his first.

Westminster Titans

Westminster continues the best start in the program's history at 7-0 after a 3-0 week including wins over Point Park (3-0), Waynesburg (5-0), and Oberlin (2-1 in double OT) ... Senior Sebastian Driver-Salazar, freshman Cory Criss and sophomore Mark Sadler posted goals against Point Park, with Anthony Beilstein making five saves in the shutout ... Sadler had a goal and an assist at Waynesburg, while senior Zach Saxman and sophomore Sam Robinson also scored ... The Jackets had two "own goals" ... Trailing 1-0 at the half against the Yeomen, Driver-Salazar hit a PK goal to tie the Oberlin game in the 71st minute, then Criss won it with a goal in the 105th minute.
