PAC Men's Soccer Player of the Week

Marsteller posted five goals and one assist for 11 points on 19 shots last week, as he led the Jackets to a 3-0 record including a double-overtime win at Thiel in the team's PAC opener. He scored the first two goals and assisted on the third in a 4-0 win over Ohio Valley, scored the game-winner with 21 seconds left in the second OT period at Thiel, and booted the lone goal in a 1-0 win over Pitt-Bradford.

Other nominees included senior F Jimmy Hershner of Bethany, sophomore F Nathaniel Jones of Grove City, junior MF Eric Hauser of Thiel, and junior MF Sebastian Driver-Salazar of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S SOCCER NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany was swept in a home-and-home with Grove City last week and is now winless in eight games ... After falling behind 1-0 early on Wednesday, Bethany MF Dave Weibe scored off an assist from Ramon Franklyn to knot the score 1-1 ... Grove City countered with five unanswered goals to pick up the win ... Saturday's affair was far more physical, with 37 fouls and three yellows being issued ... Bethany fell behind early again in the 20th minute but tied the game at 1-1 less than two minutes later ... A Grove City penalty led to a Bison PK, which senior Jimmy Hershner converted for his first goal of the year... GCC would get a goal in the 56th minute and hold on for the 2-1 win... The Bison offense continues to sputter with just three goals in 740 minutes of action.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J concluded last week with a loss and a tie ... The Presidents were handed their first blemish on their PAC slate on Wednesday as Westminster pulled out a 1-0 win at Cameron Stadium ... The Titans scored a late goal off a free kick to earn the win ... WC held a 12-9 shot advantage ... Junior goalie Mike Garet took the loss after stopping five shots in the second half ... Junior forward Mike Chiodo and junior defender Brad Cherry got W&J out to a quick 2-0 lead on Saturday, but Penn State-Behrend scored two goals in a two-minute span midway through the first half to earn the tie ... Senior goalie Brad Guinn amassed five saves in 110 minutes for the Presidents.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City continues to set the early pace in the PAC at 3-0 after sweeping Bethany last week ... Sophomore Nathaniel Jones and Adam Ludwig each had two goals and an assist in Wednesday's 6-1 home win over the Bison while Bob McNees scored twice in Saturday's victory ... Jones assisted on both McNees goals Saturday ... McNees leads the team with five goals while Jones has four goals and a team-best four assists ... The Wolverines have scored 18 goals in seven matches this year after scoring 19 in 20 contests last year ... Saturday's match at Bethany started a four-game road swing that features PAC matches at Westminster and Thiel this week ... Westminster has won five straight from Grove City ... Prior to that, Grove City had won three straight.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg is enjoying its longest win streak in two years as the Jackets posted three wins, one in PAC play, during the week ... Senior F Ian Marsteller did it all for the Jackets during the week ... In Waynesburg's 4-0 win over Ohio Valley Tuesday, Marsteller scored the first two goals and assisted on the third ... Marsteller was again catalyst in the Jackets' 3-2 double-overtime win over Thiel on Thursday, as he netted two goals, including the game-winner with 21 seconds left on an assist from Ross Philips ... Finally, Marsteller booted the lone goal on an assist from David Thorn in Waynesburg's 1-0 win over Pitt-Bradford Saturday, the team's homeopener ... Senior GK Justin Fee registered his second and third shutouts of the season during the week.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel dropped two of three games last week, which included a heartbreaking 3-2 double overtime loss to PAC rival Waynesburg ... Junior Eric Hauser netted the Ione Tomcat goal in their 4-1 loss to Hiram ... The Tomcats spotted Waynesburg a 2-0 halftime lead, but goals by junior Evan Knox and senior Jason Kolos put them right back in the game ... After a scoreless first OT, Ian Marsteller tallied his second score of the game with just 21 seconds to play in the second OT ... Senior GK David Visnicky posted eight saves in the loss ... Freshman Steven Haylett scored his team-leading fourth goal of the season in Thiel's 4-1 defeat of Pitt-Bradford Sunday ... The Tomcats and Panthers went into the half tied 1-1, but three second half goals by the Tomcats proved to be enough.

Westminster Titans

The Titan kickers opened defense of their 2002 PAC Championship on Wednesday, posting a 1-0 road victory at Washington & Jefferson ... Junior MF Sebastian Driver-Salazar converted a free kick into an unassisted goal at the 82:48 mark to give the Titans the win in their conference opener ... Senior GK Kevin Humberston made five saves to post his second shutout of the season ... Games scheduled for Friday and Saturday at Penn State-Altoona and Frostburg State, respectively, were rescheduled due to Hurricane Isabel ... Senior F Matt Roser has 31 career goals and is just two shy of tying the school record of 33 career goals set by Bill Van Ormer (1996-99) ... With 82 career points, Roser is eight shy of the career mark of 90 points set by Jason O'Connell (1993-96).
