# **BILLY CONSTANTINE Bethany College**

Senior forward Uniontown, Pa./Uniontown H.S.

Constantine tallied a goal in each of Bethany's wins last week, as the Bison were 2-0 against PAC competition with wins over Grove City (1-0) and Waynesburg (5-1). He scored the game-winner against GCC. tallying the game's only score in the 57th minute. Against the Yellow Jackets, he scored the game's first goal to tie for the team goal lead with four this season.

Other nominees included senior GK Brad Smith of Grove City, senior GK Jeremy Rotzell of Thiel, sophomore MF Brad Cherry of Washington & Jefferson, senior F Ben Roman of Waynesburg and senior GK Kevin Humberston of Westminster.

# **Bethany Bison**

Bethany moved to 4-0-1 in PAC play with two more league wins last week ... The Bison recorded a 1-0 victory over Grove City on a goal by Billy Constantine in the 57th minute ... Despite the narrow difference on the scoreboard, the Bison outshot the Wolverines 28-4 ... In two games this season, Bethany has outshot GCC 47-10 ... Keeper Ryann Bradley posted his second shutout of the year by stopping three shots ... In the Waynesburg triumph, forward Ehren Grill broke a 1-1 tie late in the first half and the Bison scored three goals in the second half to put the game away ... Five different players found the back of the net, including Constantine, Grill, Brent Coffey, Daniel Reinoso and Steven Wood.

## Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J capped a wild week with a 2-1 double-OT victory over Wittenberg on Saturday at the Wilmington Tournament ... The Presidents were scheduled to play Wittenberg on Friday and Wilmington on Saturday, however, inclement weather forced Friday's action to Saturday and cancelled Saturday's games ... Sophomore Brad Cherry took a feed from sophomore Andy Komar to lift the Presidents to the win with two minutes remaining in the second OT period ... Sophomore Mike Chiodo scored the other President goal ... Junior Brad Guinn accumulated seven saves in the net ... W&J also played a double-overtime contest earlier in week, falling to Westminster, 1-0 ... Guinn once again played all 104 minutes and made 12 saves.

The Tomcats went 1-1-1 last week, picking up their first-ever PAC victory with a 2-0 victory over Waynesburg on Thursday ... In the tie with Hiram, sophomore Dan Cookson managed nine shots for the Tomcats, who were outshot by the Terriers 28-14 ... Rotzell posted his second shutout of the week in the victory against Waynesburg, a win in which the Tomcats outshot the Yellow Jackets 7-3 and held a 22-1 advantage in corner kicks ... Senior Bill Douglas and Cookson connected on the two Thiel goals.

## Westminster Titans

The Westminster men's soccer team reached the .500 mark overall by winning its first two PAC contests this week, with shutouts at W&J (1-0) and Thiel (5-0) ... Senior GK Kevin Humberston earned both wins in goal, making six saves in 104 minutes against W&J and posting two saves in 76 minutes versus Thiel ...
