#### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets



Waynesburg started the week with a record-setting 10-1 win over Mount Aloysius before losing to La Roche and Notre Dame (OH) ... In

the victory over the Mounties, the Yellow Jackets set a single-game school record with 10 goals, including two goals from each J.C. Danhires, Ronnie Wilson and Jeremy Pronto ...
