For the second time this season, the Saints had a non-conference game cancelled/rescheduled due to weather as the game with Centre was cancelled ... The Saints will host Grove City this week at Xavier University in Cincinnati, Ohio on Saturday before traveling to Franklin, Ind., for a non-conference game with the Grizzlies.



## Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J posted a 2-0-1 record during the week, its first week without a loss during the season ... The Presidents increased their win streak against Waynesburg to 15 matches after freshman MF **Dan Hart** scored the game's lone goal in the eighth minute ... W&J grabbed an early lead against Thomas More on Wednesday on junior

MF **Sean Park**'s goal, but the Saints forced the tie in the second half after scoring on a corner kick ... W&J took a 1-0 lead versus Thiel on Saturday 11 seconds into the match and never looked back en route to a 5-0 victory ...
