Beard led the Presidents to a 3-0 week by scoring a goal in all three W&J wins, including the game-winner in a 1-0 victory at Penn State-Altoona. He netted the first goal in a 3-2 PAC win over Waynesburg and gave the Presidents a two-goal cushion with a second-half goal in a 4-2 win at Thomas More.

Other nominees included junior MF David Peters of Waynesburg and junior D Todd Atwood of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany tasted defeat for the first time in 2005 by falling 2-0 at Frostburg State Thursday ... The Bobcats scored 44 seconds into the match and added another goal in the 29th minute for the final difference ... The Bison actually outshot Frostburg 13-11, including an 8-6 advantage in the first half, but could not get one past Bobcat keeper **Bryn Varhol** ... BC continued its six-game road trip Saturday with a trek out to Wilmington ... The Quakers would also post a pair of first half scores en route to a 2-0 victory over the Green and White ... Bethany's road trip continues this week with PAC games at Thomas More Tuesday and Thiel Saturday.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City fell to 2-1-1 in the PAC Saturday with a 3-0 loss at Westminster ... The match was scoreless at halftime ... Last Wednesday, the Wolverines dropped a 2-1 decision at Penn State Behrend ... Junior **Bob McNees** scored an unassisted goal in the first half to give Grove City the lead but Behrend rallied in the second half ... Grove City's match Monday with Lake Erie has been postponed with no makeup date announced ... Grove City hosts Thiel Wednesday and Geneva Friday ... The program will induct former standouts **Jim Pontier** and **Philip Ahlschlager** into its Hall of Fame Saturday ... They are the 14th and 15th inductees into the Hall since its 2001 creation.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats dropped a 3-1 loss at Case Western on Wednesday before falling in their PAC opener at Waynesburg 2-0 Saturday afternoon ... Against CWRU, freshman **Dorran Coley** tied the game at 1-1 in the 22nd minute when he headed in a cross from freshman **Elliot Wreh-Wilson** ... The goal was Coley's second of the season ... Sophomore GK **Ryan Lewis** posted 11 saves in the loss ... After battling the Yellow Jackets to a 0-0 deadlock through the opening 45 minutes, Waynesburg's **David Peters** registered both second-half goals in the 2-0 win ... Lewis finished with eight saves.



Thomas More Saints

Senior **Eric Busener** and **Kris Weber** each scored a goal in the Saints' 4-2 loss to Washington & Jefferson ... three of the game's six goals came off penalty kicks ... It was the first-ever match-up for the Saint men's soccer team with Washington & Jefferson ... The upcoming Bethany game on Tuesday will mark the first time the two teams have met since Thomas More joined the NCAA in 1990 ... Thomas More owns a 6-1 series edge over the Franklin Grizzlies, including four straight.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

W&J had its best week of 2005 as it posted three victories, including two PAC wins ... Sophomore MF **Brian Beard** scored the lone goal in the 27th minute in a 1-0 victory at P.S.-Altoona Monday ... Freshman GK **Tyler Hodgins** made two saves for his first career shutout ... Beard opened the scoring in the victory at Waynesburg and an own goal by the Jackets proved to be the difference in a 3-2 triumph ... Hodgins again made two saves in helping the Presidents fight back from a 2-1 halftime deficit ... Junior MF **Mike Seminerio** had a career day Sunday at Thomas More as he played a role in all four W&J goals with three scores and one assist ... Seminerio converted two penalty kicks and assisted on a Beard goal ... Hodgins made it a perfect 3-0 week with one save.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets posted a 1-3 overall mark, including a split of two conference games this week. Waynesburg started the week with a 2-1 setback to Malone, an NAIA school ... Junior MF **David Peters** scored the lone goal for the Yellow Jackets in the loss, while GK **Matt Lamp** posted seven saves on 15 Malone shot attempts ... In the conference game against Washington & Jefferson, Waynesburg held a 2-1 lead after goals from F **Michael Wilson** and Peters before the Presidents scored the final two goals of the game ... Peters continued his goal-scoring stretch on Saturday when he netted both goals in Waynesburg's 2-0 victory over Thiel ... Lamp registered five saves on seven Tomcat attempts.



Westminster Titans

Westminster posted a pair of home wins last week, topping Pitt-Greensburg 4-2 Tuesday before recording a 3-0 shutout over PAC rival Grove City Saturday ... The UP-G match was a rematch of last year's NCAA Tournament contest, won 1-0 by Westminster at Greensburg ... Sophomore F **Andy Saporito** has a goal and an assist vs. UP-G, while junior MF **Blake Ordell**, senior MF **Fritz Julien** and sophomore F **Keith Little** added goals ... After a scoreless first half, the Titans scored three goals in a 13-minute span in the second half against GCC ... Junior D **Todd Atwood** scored the first two goals, while sophomore D **Matt Kuza** added one ... Freshman GK **David Kroll** made nine saves for his first collegiate career shutout.
