McNees led Grove City to a 2-0 week with PAC wins at Westminster (1-0) and Grove City (1-0), which left the Wolverines alone in first place in the conference at 5-0. He scored the lone goal in the Westminster game off a direct kick in the 65th minute. McNees currently leads the Wolverines with six goals in 2003.

Other nominees included sophomore D Lavel Williams of Bethany, freshman F Steve Haylett of Thiel, junior D Brad Cherry of Washington & Jefferson, and senior F Todd Fisher of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany dropped two more games last week to fall to 0-9-1 ... The Bison took their first lead of the season against Frostburg Thursday on a Lavel Williams goal in the 14th minute ... But the Bobcats tied the game by halftime and tallied goals in the 63rd and 71st minutes to record the win ... GK Adam Seifert made nine saves in the loss ... At Wilmington, the Quakers dominated throughout for the win ... The hosts outshot BC 26-4 and held a 7-1 advantage in corners ... The Green and White will have two home games this week to try to get their first win ... Geneva comes to Hoag Field Wednesday and Waynesburg ventures in Oct. 4 for the Bison's Homecoming.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

With 31 career goals, junior forward Mike Chiodo is just three away from becoming W&J's all-time leading goal scorer ... The Presidents split a pair of PAC contests last week, defeating Waynesburg at home before falling at Westminster in OT over the weekend ... Despite falling behind 1-0 to the Yellow Jackets, W&J ripped off five unanswered goals to close the game ... Junior F Andy Komar scored one goal and added one assist, while freshman MF Mike Seminiero dished out two helpers ... Chiodo put in the Presidents' first goal and junior defender Brad Cherry scored the game-winner on a penalty kick in the 18th minute ... Cherry and Komar helped W&J fight back from an early 2-0 deficit on Saturday, but the Titans earned their second win over W&J in as many weeks with a goal five minutes into OT.

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverines capped the first half of conference schedule at 5-0 after a pair of 1-0 road PAC victories ... Freshman Bob McNees scored the lone goal against Westminster off a direct kick, his sixth goal of the season ... Junior Ben Hoffman recorded his first goal of the season Saturday at Thiel, providing the margin of victory ... Joel Gladfelder had the shutout in goal against Westminster while freshman Dave Mahtani had the shutout against Thiel ... It was Mahtani's first start and his first collegiate victory ... Grove City steps out of conference for a pair of matches this week ... After visiting Behrend Wednesday, Grove City hosts national powerhouse Messiah Saturday afternoon ... It is Grove City's first four-match win streak since 2001, when Grove City started 9-2.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

In a return to conference play, Waynesburg suffered a 5-1 defeat from Washington & Jefferson ... The loss snapped a three-game winning streak for the Yellow Jackets ... Senior Mike Pilarski scored the lone goal of the Jackets, which was the first in the game, on an assist from Luke Benton and David Peters ... The Presidents held reigning PAC Player of the Week Ian Marsteller scoreless for the first time in three games ... Marsteller posted a team-high three shots in the loss ... Senior goalkeeper Justin Fee made 11 saves on 19 shots for the Jackets.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats went 1-1 last week, earning a 3-2 victory over Ohio Valley in Parkersburg, WV and suffering a tough 1-0 loss to Grove City at Alumni Stadium ... Freshman Steve Haylett netted a pair of goals in Wednesday's win, giving him a team-high six on the season ... Senior Jason Kolos assisted on two of the Tomcats' three scores against OVC ... Junior Dan Cookson had a goal and an assist in the non-conference win ... Grove City's Ben Hoffman broke a scoreless tie with under nine minutes to play Saturday in the Wolverines 1-0 win ... Senior GK David Visnicky recorded three saves against the PAC's top team ... Thiel has posted 15 goals and 11 assists through 11 games in 2003 after putting up just 19 goals and nine assists in 20 games in 2002.

Westminster Titans

The Titan kickers split a pair of PAC contests last week, dropping a battle for first place with Grove City 1-0 before posting a 3-2 overtime win over W&J on Saturday ... With two goals against the Presidents, senior F Matt Roser now has 33 career goals, tying the school record for career goals originally set by Bill Van Ormer (1996-99) ... With 86 career points, Roser is four shy of the career mark of 90 points set by Jason O'Connell (1993-96) ... Senior F Todd Fisher hit the game-winner against W&J in the 95th minute unassisted ... Freshman D Jacob Reed posted his first collegiate career assist on Roser's first goal ... Senior GK Kevin Humberston made four saves against Grove City and seven saves against Washington & Jefferson.
