Humberston posted his third and fourth consecutive PAC shutouts this week, leading the Titans to wins over Grove City (2-0) and W&J (3-0). He posted four saves in the Grove City win and five saves against Washington & Jefferson. Humberston has not given up a goal in his last 400:08 in goal, since a goal by Pitt-Greensburg in the 63rd minute on Sept. 15.

Other nominees included senior GK **Ryann Bradley** of Bethany, senior GK **Brad Smith** of Grove City, and sophomore F **Andy Komar** of Washington & Jefferson.

The Bison went 1-0-1 last week, claiming a 4-1 victory over Frostburg before settling for a scoreless tie with Wilmington ... Midfielder Dan Irwin scored his first goals of the year and midfielder Daniel Reinoso had a goal and an assist in the Frostburg win ... Papa Sane opened the scoring with his second goal of the year in the 25th minute ... Justin Kosta, Brent Coffey and Steven Wood collected assists on the day ... The Wilmington draw was as close as the score indicated ... Bethany outshot the Quakers 21-19 and corner kicks were even at eight apiece ... Junior keeper Adam Seifert replaced Ryann Bradley, who left due to injury, in the first minute of the first overtime and made six saves to preserve the tie.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson split a pair of PAC contests this week, defeating Waynesburg and falling to Westminster ... Sophomores forward Andy Komar and midfielder Joe Perhacs each scored two goals in the win at Waynesburg, while three Presidents goalkeepers combined to make three saves in the shutout ... Forwards sophomore Joe Findley and freshman Joe Santnia each scored their first goals of the season in the win ... Westminster jumped out to a 2-0 lead on Saturday and hung on to shutout the Presidents, 3-0, in a battle of two of the top teams in the conference.

Grove City Wolverines

Wolverines snapped an eight-game winless streak with a 1-0 shutout of visiting Thiel at rain-soaked College Field Friday afternoon ... Peter Williams scored his first goal of the season to give Grove City the lead early in the second half ... Goalkeeper Brad Smith made two saves to record his second shutout of the season ... Grove City is allowing less than one goal per game in conference play ... Grove City outshot Thiel, 18-3 ... Smith made eight saves in a setback at Westminster last Wednesday ... Grove City's next three matches are also at home ... Seven of Grove City's first nine games were on the road.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg is suffering from its worst losing skid of the season at four games, after a 7-0 loss to Washington & Jefferson on Tuesday ... The Jackets recorded only one shot on goal in the loss, while junior goalkeeper **Justin Fee** stopped nine of the Presidents' 16 shots.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats managed a split last week, falling to Grove City 1-0 and earning a 1-0 forfeit victory over D'Youville College Sunday afternoon ... Senior keeper **Jeremy Rotzell** made 10 stops against Grove City ...
