He then led the W&J defensive effort which limited Geneva to just three shots on goal.

## **Bethany Bison**



Playing their first match in nearly two weeks, the Bison opened PAC action with a 1-1 tie vs. Grove City ... Junior Andrew McPherson

gave BC an early lead with his fourth goal of the year just 3:56 into the match ... Freshman **Ari Dewhurst** assisted on the goal for his eighth point of the year to tie McPherson for the team-lead ... GCC evened the contest in the 64<sup>th</sup> minute ... It was the first goal allowed by the Bison in a PAC regular season match since a match against W&J on Oct. 26, 2005, a span of more than 650 minutes ... Junior **Chad Perry** made four saves for the Bison ... After the lengthy layoff, Saturday was the first of four PAC matches in a seven-day span, as the Bison travel to Thiel, Waynesburg and Westminster this week.

#### Saint Vincent Bearcats



Saint Vincent started the week with a tough 3-1 defeat to Frostburg State ... The Bearcats lone goal was a **Dave Lauteri** goal in the 27th minute ... SVC controlled play through-

out the second half, but FSU scored two goals over the final three minutes for the win ... SVC then faced its toughest opponent of the season, traveling to Messiah College, the 2006 D-III national champion, currently ranked second in the nation by d3kicks.com ... SVC put up a fight, trailing only 1-0 heading into halftime on a disputed Messiah goal, before falling 3-0 ... Saturday, SVC traveled to Westminster, tying the Titans 3-3 as Sean Molyneaux, Ben Fecik, and Jason Zielinski provided goals.
