McNees tied a Grove City school record when he posted four goals in a 5-1 PAC win over Thiel. He also assisted on GCC's other goal against the Tomcats. The Wolverines were 1-0-1 last week, including a 1-1 tie in two overtimes against NAIA member Geneva,

Other nominees included sophomore F Ashkan Alavy of Bethany, senior GK Tyler Hodgins of Washington & Jefferson, and junior D Sam Robinson of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

The Bison rebounded from their first two losses of the season the week before by taking a pair of PAC matches last week to move to 4-0-1 in the league ... In a 1-0 victory over Thomas More Tuesday, senior **Lavel Williams** scored the game's only goal in the 24th minute off a double-assist from **Mike Aivalis** and **Ashkan Alavy** ... Sophomore GK **Kosta Floros** did the rest, as he stopped six shots for his sixth shutout of the season ... The second win came in the form of a 3-1 triumph at Thiel Saturday ... Alavy scored twice in the first half and junior **Sean Esterbauer** converted a PK early in the second half for all the Bison scoring ... A late goal by the Tomcats was the first score the Bison had allowed in five PAC contests this season.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats suffered three conference losses last week ... Westminster dealt the Tomcats a 2-1 loss Monday, followed by a 5-1 defeat at Grove City Wednesday and a 3-1 home setback to Bethany Saturday ... The Tomcats have failed to score multiple goals in eight of their first nine contests this season ... Against Westminster, junior **Travis Reges** scored his first goal of the season in the 87th minute off of an assist by freshman **Dorran Coley** to pull the Tomcats to within one ... Sophomore GK **Ryan Lewis** finished with 10 saves against the Titans ... Freshman **Kyle Rand** tallied the Tomcat's only goal against the Wolverines ... Sophomore **Nikola Vasilev** tallied the lone score in the 88th minute against Bethany, while Lewis recorded 11 saves.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Washington & Jefferson has posted a 30-9-3 record in its last 42 PAC matches ... The Presidents remained atop the PAC standings this week after posting shutout victories at home over Waynesburg and Westminster ... Junior MF **Mike Seminerio** scored the game's lone goal with 10 minutes remaining in the first half and freshman GK **Tyler Hodgins** picked up one save to lead W&J ... Midfielders junior **Brian Witkovitz** and freshman **Ryan McDonald** scored first-half goals in the win over the Titans on Saturday ... Hodgins stopped two shots for his third career shutout ... All three W&J losses this season have been by one goal.



Westminster Titans

Westminster split a pair of PAC contests last week, as the Titans posted a 2-1 win at Thiel Monday before falling 2-0 at W&J Saturday ... Westminster took a 1-0 lead over Thiel into halftime, as junior MF **Blake Ordell** took a cross from classmate **Alex Castillo** and found the back of the net in the 33rd minute ... The Titans stretched the lead to 2-0 with just under 15 minutes to play, when junior **Sam Robinson** headed in a goal with an assist by freshman defender **Chris Ellwanger** ... Junior **Anthony Beislstein** went the distance in goal for the Titans, posting three saves in the win ... In the loss at W&J, sophomore GK **Chris Passione** made four saves.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City improved to 3-1-1 in the PAC Wednesday with a 5-1 win over Thiel ... Junior F **Bob McNeas** tied a Grove City record with four goals against the Tomcats ... He scored twice in a 31-second span in the first half to help the Wolverines take a 3-0 halftime lead ... McNeas also scored twice in the second half ... Senior **Nate Jones** scored Grove City's first goal in the seventh minute with McNeas providing the assist ... Jones assisted McNeas twice while **Matt Sol** and **Adam Ludwig** both had assists ... Against future PAC rival Geneva Friday, Grove City rallied for a 1-1 double-overtime draw ... Jones scored in the 85th minute to forge the tie ... GK **Michael Manahan** preserved the tie with four saves, including one in the second OT.



Thomas More Saints

Thomas More lost two games this week each by one goal ... In a 2-1 loss to Franklin, the game-winning goal was scored on a penalty kick in the 87th minute, two minutes after TMC had tied the game 1-1 ... It was the second time in two weeks, the Saints lost a contest with the game-winning goal coming on a penalty kick ... Freshman **Tyler Smith** scored the lone goal of the week ... After the Hanover contest, Thomas More plays six straight Presidents' Athletic Conference games.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

In its lone game of the week, the Waynesburg College men's soccer team suffered a 1-0 loss to two-time reigning conference champion Washington & Jefferson under the lights on Wednesday night ... The Presidents scored the game's lone goal in the 36th minute when **Mike Seminerio** scored an unassisted goal ... The Presidents attacked the Yellow Jacket net on Wednesday, attempting 25 shots compared to just four by Waynesburg ... Waynesburg GK **Matt Lamp** recorded six saves in the loss, while F **Michael Wilson** and MF **David Peters** each posted a pair of shot attempts in the loss.
