# Bethany Bison

The Bison went 2-1 last week and are now 6-5 overall this season and 2-1 in the PAC ... Sophomore Brian Bajek scored a goal and an assist to lead the Bison past Grove City, 3-0 ... Bajek added another goal in the victory against Waynesburg ... BC also got goals from freshmen Myles McKenzie, Aston Duporte and Tim Fratto against the Yellow Jackets ... In that game, Waynesburg took a 1-0 lead 7:56 into the game, but Bethany responded with four unanswered goals ... Fratto tied the game at the 11:18 mark and McKenzie gave Bethany the lead for good with 5:13 left in the first half ... Junior Danny Orwa scored his first career goal in the loss to Frostburg State.

## Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J split a pair of matches last week, falling to Westminster at home, 2-1, and then earning a 2-0 shutout of Kenyon Saturday in Washington .... The Titans and Presidents were tied at the half Wednesday, but an early Westminster goal in the second half proved to be the difference ... Sophomore MF Brian Witkovitz scored the lone W&J goal off an assist from freshman D Kyle Burnell ... Senior GK Mike Garet made six saves in the loss ... Garet posted three saves in the shutout of Kenyon ... The Presidents took a 1-0 lead in the 23rd minute as sophomore MF Mike Seminerio scored off an assist from senior F Mike Chiodo ... Senior F Andy Komar made it 2-0 in the 63rd minute as he headed home a cross from Witkovitz.

# **Grove City Wolverines**

The Wolverines closed the week with a pair of 2-1 victories, including an overtime win Saturday at Geneva ... Sophomore Bob McNees registered a pair of multi-goal efforts last week, scoring the game-winner in both victories ... McNees scored twice in the final 16 minutes at Thiel, then scored in overtime at Geneva ... Senior Peter Williams assisted McNees on each of the game-winners while senior Ben Hoffman assisted on McNees' first goal in both matches ... Senior goalkeeper Joel Gladfelter had 17 saves combined in the two wins ... The Wolverines host rival Westminster Tuesday in their lone match of the week.

# Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg has lost five of its last six, including two this week. The Yellow Jackets were overmatched against NAIA Notre Dame (Ohio), getting shutout 7-0 ... Against the Falcons, the Jacket defense for third straight game allowed a hat trick to an opposing player ... The Jackets returned to conference play Saturday and were defeated by Bethany, 4-1, and remain winless in four conference games. The Bison played a much more physical game committing 20 fouls in the win and outshot the Jackets 18-6 ... Senior cocaptain Nick West scored the lone goal of the week for the Jackets, which gave Waynesburg an early lead ... In its last six games, Waynesburg has scored just seven goals while allowing 23 goals and recorded only one win.

### **Thiel Tomcats**

The Tomcats dropped a pair of heartbreaking PAC contests last week, falling to Grove City 2-1 Wednesday before losing in double overtime to undefeated Westminster 2-1 Sunday ... Thiel jumped out to a 1-0 halftime lead against the Wolverines, but the GCC was able to counter with a pair of scores in the second half ... The Tomcats got on the board in the 22nd minute on a goal from freshman MF Enzo Giambanco set up by a cross from freshman F Nikola Vasilev ... Trailing Westminster 1-0 at the half, Thiel responded with a score in the 74th minute to tie the game at 1-1 when Vasilev scored off of an assist from freshman MF Frank Ily.

#### Westminster Titans

The best start in Titan soccer history continued with two more PAC wins, as Westminster improved to a perfect 11-0 with 2-1 wins at W&J and Thiel ... Freshman F Andy Saporito and freshman MF Garrett Horvath scored against the Presidents, with sophomore MF Alex Castillo assisting on both goals ... Sophomore GK Anthony Beilstein made three saves in the league victory ... At Thiel, freshman F Cory Criss opened the scoring with a goal assisted by Horvath and senior D Nick White ... With one minute to play in the second OT period, sophomore M Todd Atwood scored the game-winner by heading in a cross from senior D Christian Davoli.
