PAC PLAY UNDERWAY: The PAC conference schedule got underway this past weekend with four league games ... Defending PAC champion Thomas More had little difficulty in a 5-0 victory over visiting Thiel ... Geneva posted a dramatic win in its first-ever official PAC contest, as the Golden Tornadoes prevailed at home 2-1 in overtime over Washington & Jefferson ... Grove City was victorious at Bethany 1-0, while Westminster recorded a 4-0 home decision against Saint Vincent.

NEWS & NOTES: Thomas More moved up to #22 in the NSCAA/Continental Tire national Top 25 poll last week ... Senior M **Coty Hainsey** posted three goals in two matches for 1-1 Westminster, including a pair of scores in the Titans' 4-0 PAC opening win vs. Saint Vincent ... Freshman **Jeremy Troutman** scored the game-winning goal for Geneva in overtime against Washington & Jefferson ... Junior F **Andrew Quinn** of Grove City scored the long goal in the Wolverine match at Bethany in the game's fourth minute.
