Bethany Bison

Bethany improved to 5-0-1 in the PAC with a 3-1 win at Thiel before dropping a 6-0 score to #1 Messiah Saturday ... Midfielder **Daniel Reinoso** scored two goals, including the tying goal on a PK and **Brent Coffey** scored the game-winner early in the second half ... Midfielder **Jimmy Hershner** had two assists in the Thiel win ... Against the top-ranked Falcons, Messiah scored two goals in the opening 11 minutes and put the game away with four second half tallies.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J split a pair of contests last week, falling to non-conference opponent LaRoche, 3-1, on Wednesday before bouncing back to edge Thiel, 1-0, on Saturday in Greenville ... The Presidents jumped out to a 1-0 lead on La Roche on a goal by sophomore **Andy Komar** off a corner kick assist from sophomore **Mike Chiodo**, but the Redhawks scored three unanswered goals to claim the win ... Chiodo scored the lone goal for W&J on Saturday off a free kick in the 25th minute and W&J hung on with a solid defensive effort behind junior goalie **Brad Guinn**, who notched three saves in recording his third shutout of the season ... W&J hosts Waynesburg and Penn State-Behrend at Cameron Stadium this week.

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverines have strung together a two-game unbeaten streak ... Grove City rallied for a 1-1 tie with Behrend last Wednesday ... For the second straight game, **Peter Williams** scored Grove City's lone goal, scoring an unassisted goal late in the first half ... Williams and **Matt Dobson** share the team lead in goals ... Goalkeeper **Brad Smith** made 10 saves as the Wolverines were outshot, 28-7 ... In conference games, Grove City has allowed just four goals in its five matches as Smith owns a pair of shutouts against PAC foes ... The Wolverines are now 9-3-2 against the Allegheny Mountain Collegiate Conference since 2000 ... Grove City is in the middle of four-game homestand.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg's losing streak sinks to five as the Jackets lost its only game of the week to Westminster, 6-0 ... **Justin Fee** stopped 12 shots in net for the Jackets, while **Nick West** recorded Waynesburg's lone shot ... The Jackets were out-shot in the game 20-1.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats finished 1-2 last week, suffering two losses to PAC rivals Bethany (3-1) and W&J (1-0) and defeating Pitt-Bradford (2-1) ... Sophomore **Dan Cookson** tallied the Tomcats lone goal versus Bethany, a header off of a corner kick by senior **Brian Stenger** ... Senior keeper **Jeremy Rotzell** made nine stops against the Bison ... An early goal helped W&J defeat the Tomcats 1-0 on Saturday ... Battling through a 0-0 halftime tie, the Tomcats broke loose for two goals in their 2-1 defeat at Pitt-Bradford ... Freshman **Chris Sayers** tallied the Tomcats first goal and senior **Bill Douglas** knocked in the game-winner off of a double assist from Cookson and junior **Jonathan Bobabick**.

Westminster Titans

Westminster improved to a perfect 5-0 in PAC play, all shutouts, and remained percentage points ahead of Bethany (5-0-1) in the PAC standings with a 6-0 home shutout of Waynesburg on Wednesday in the team's only game last week ...
