PAC Men's Soccer Player of the Week

ANDY KOMAR Washington & Jefferson College

Senior forward Pittsburgh, Pa./Thomas Jefferson H.S.

Komar scored both game-winning overtime goals for the Presidents in PAC wins over Waynesburg (3-2) and Westminster (2-1) last week. For the week, he had three goals and an assist for seven points.

Other nominees included junior F Lavel Williams of Bethany, sophomore F Bob McNees of Grove City, and sophomore MF Todd Atwood of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S SOCCER NOTES

Bethany Bison

Bethany went 2-0 last week and outscored its opponents 9-2 in those games, including a 4-0 shutout at Thiel on Thursday ... The Bison also defeated Point Park at home on Monday after falling behind 2-0 in the first half ... Brian Bajek tallied two goals against Point Park, while Lavel Williams, Danny Orwa and Chris Milenkovski also added goals ... It was Milenkovski's first career goal ... Williams led the victory over the Tomcats with two goals and an assist to total eight points for the week ... He is now second on the team with 12 points this season ... Milenkovski added his second career goal against the Tomcats, with the other goal coming from Ramon Franklyn on a penalty kick.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents moved above .500 for the first time since winning its season opener this week after two overtime PAC wins ... Senior F Andy Komar scored three goals in the two victories, including the overtime game winner in both matches ... Komar scored the game winner just over two minutes into the first overtime period at Waynesburg off an assist from sophomore MF Mike Seminerio ... Seminerio also assisted on Komar's first goal ... Senior F Mike Chiodo netted the other W&J goal off an assist from Komar ... Senior GK Mike Garet earned the win after making five saves ... Chiodo tied the contest at Westminster with five minutes left off an assist from junior D Andrew Enrietti and then Chiodo assisted on Komar's game-winning score in OT.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City extended its win streak to four with two shutout wins in PAC play last week ... Grove City ended Westminster's 11-0 start as **Bob McNees** scored a pair of second-half goals ... Peter Williams and Nate Jones each had assists ... McNees scored Grove City's Ione goal Friday in a 1-0 win at Waynesburg with Williams supplying the assist ... McNees has scored the game-winner in all four matches during the streak with Williams assisting on all four game-winners ... In goal, Joel Gladfelter picked up two shutout wins, giving him five this season ... McNees has seven game-winning goals this year ... His 13 goals is the highest total for a Grove City player since Greg Kreutzberg's school-record 25 in 1996.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg remained winless in conference play this season, following one-goal losses last week to Washington & Jefferson, 2-3, and Grove City, 0-1 ... The Yellow Jackets have lost six straight, including five to conference opponents ... The Jackets came back from a two-goal deficit in the second half against the Presidents to force the game into overtime, where the Jackets allowed the game-winning goal less than two minutes into the extra frame ... John **Danhires** scored his first collegiate goal in the game against W&J, while freshman Michael Wilson added his teamleading sixth goal ... The Jackets have been outscored 21-6 during their sixgame losing streak.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel dropped its only contest last week, falling at home to Bethany 4-0 ... The Bison held a 1-0 lead at the half but broke it open in the second with three goals in the game's final nine minutes ... Freshman F **Nikola Vasilev** was ranked 19th in the last Division III statistics report, averaging 1.0 goals per game ... He is tied for the school's single-season goal scoring lead with nine this season.

Westminster Titans

Westminster saw its program-best 11-0 start come to an end this week with PAC losses at Grove City (2-0) Tuesday and at home against Washington & Jefferson (2-1 in overtime) Saturday ... Titan sophomore GK Anthony Beilstein made three saves in the loss to the Wolverines ... Against W&J, Westminster opened the scoring six minutes into the second half, as sophomore Todd Atwood posted an unassisted goal for a 1-0 Titan lead .. Westminster appeareed headed for the win until the Presidents' knotted the score at 1-1 with just four minutes to play ... Five minutes into the first extra session, W&J ended the game on a goal by Andy Komar ... Beilstein went the distance in goal in the loss, making seven saves.
