PAC Men's Soccer Player of the Week

MIKE CHIODO Washington & Jefferson College

Sophomore forward Pittsburgh, Pa./Chartiers Valley H.S.

Chiodo posted two goals and three assists in a 2-0 week for W&J, as the Presidents topped PAC rival Waynesburg 2-1 before handing non-conference opponent Penn State-Behrend 2-1 (only its second loss of the season.). He scored one goal and had three assists in the PAC win against the Jackets, then scored the first goal against PS-B. Although only a sophomore, Chiodo moved into second place on the W&J career goal charts with 21.

Other nominees included junior MF **Dustin King** of Grove City, junior GK **Justin Fee** of Waynesburg, and freshman F **Anthony Makuch-Lott** of Westminster.

Bethany dropped its only match of the week with a 1-0 loss on the road at Penn State Behrend ... It was the Bison's first loss to Behrend in three meetings ... Bethany gets back to PAC play this week with home games against Waynesburg and their first meeting of the season with PAC leader Westminster.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City dropped a pair of conference matches at home last week ... Wolverines scored the first goal in each match ... **Dustin King** scored Grove City's goal against Westminster last Wednesday while **Nate Jones** scored three minutes into Saturday's match with Waynesburg ... Goalkeeper **Brad Smith** made eight saves during the week ... Four of Grove City's next five matches are away from home.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel dropped their only game last week, falling to Notre Dame College 3-1 in Cleveland ... Senior **Brian Stenger** scored his first goal of the season in the loss ... Senior GK **Jeremy Rotzell** made eight stops in net for the Tomcats... Thiel will travel to Westminster on Thursday and will host Case Western Reserve at 12 p.m. Sunday.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J extended its winning streak to a season-high three games with wins over Waynesburg and Penn State-Altoona this week ... Sophomore D Brad Cherry scored two goals and sophomore F Mike Chiodo added one goal and three assists in the victory over the Yellow Jackets ... Freshman MF Luis Rosales also added one goal and one assist ... Freshman F Joe Santina led the Presidents to the one-goal win over Penn State-Altoona with an unassisted tally in the 35th minute ... The Presidents handed the Lions their second loss of the season and outshot them 15-11 ... Junior Brad Guinn was awarded the win in goal after notching three saves.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg erased a six-game losing streak on Saturday with a 2-1 win over Grove City, the team's first in PAC action ... The Jackets came back from a one-goal deficit as **Ben Roman** and **Luke Benton** booted goals for Waynesburg. Grove City controlled the game with advantages in corner kicks (10-0) and shots (27-5), but thanks to junior goalkeeper **Justin Fee**'s 26 saves the Jackets maintained the lead ... Waynesburg (3-9-1, 1-5-1) began the week with a 6-1 loss at Washington & Jefferson as **Will Pradera** scored the Jackets lone goal.

Westminster Titans

Westminster improved to a perfect 6-0 in PAC play with a 2-1 road win at Grove City in the team's only game of the week on Wednesday ... The Titans trailed 1-0 at the half, but a goal by freshman Anthony Makuch-Lott tied the game, then junior Matthew Roser scored the game-winner midway through the second period ... Senior Kevin **Humberston** went the distance in goal, making three saves ... WC has won six straight games, all over PAC teams, and has outscored its opposition 19-1 during that span ... The Titan kickers have three games this week, culminating with a showdown at Bethany for first place in the PAC on Saturday at 3 p.m.
