PAC Offensive Player of the Week

CHAD SWISHER Thiel Freshman F Alliance, Ohio Alliance H.S.



Swisher netted his first collegiate hat trick with three goals for the Tomcats in Thiel's 4-1 PAC win at Waynesburg on Monday. He now has 22 points (9G, 4 A) on the season, the second-best total in Thiel history.

Also nominated was junior M Mike Aivalis of Bethany, junior M Jeremy Delmaster of Washington & Jefferson, and freshman M Aaron Zavora of Westminster.

McDonald led the W&J back line to a 1-0-1 week against PAC opposition. He had a hand in the first three goals of W&J's 4-1 PAC win over Thiel, assisting on the first two (including the game-winner) before scoring the third.

Also nominated was senior D **John Zervos** of Bethany, and freshman GK **Mike Codita** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison



The Bison finished 1-1 in two non-conference outings last week ... After battling Franciscan through 81 scoreless minutes. BC scored two

goals in 55 seconds and held off a Baron rally for a 2-1 triumph ... Junior **Mike Aivalis** assisted on **Cory Estes**' goal for a 1-0 Bethany lead, then scored his first of the season less than a minute later for the 2-0 lead ... It was the first goal of Aivalis' career ... On Saturday for Homecoming, the Bison dropped a 1-0 decision to Point Park ... The defeat came despite Bethany posting a 21-1 shot advantage, including a 13-0 margin in the second half ... BC will host Saint Vincent Wednesday and PAC co-leader W&J Saturday in a crucial PAC match-up.

The game was decided just two minutes into OT on a Fecik goal from 15 yards out, with Rodriguez getting the assist.

Thiel Tomcats



The Tomcats went 1-1 last week in PAC play, earning a 4-1 victory at Waynesburg Monday before falling at W&J 4-1 on Saturday ... Freshman F Chad Swisher

paced the Tomcats with his first collegiate hat trick against the Yellow Jackets ... The PAC win against the Yellow Jackets was Thiel's first league victory since picking up a 3-2 victory over Thomas More College on Oct. 27, 2005 ... Freshman MF Charles Osbourne netted his second goal of the season against the Presidents while Swisher, with an assist, added to his team-best 22 points ... Sophomore GK Tim Smith had eight saves in the loss.

Thomas More Saints



Thomas More won its only game of the week that counts in the PAC standings, beating Grove City, 1-0 ... The only goal of
