Westminster Titans

Westminster split two matches during the week ... The Titans edged visiting Grove City, 1-0, Wednesday as junior F **Andrew Saporito** scored the game-winning goal by posting his team-high sixth goal of the season ... Saporito beat Grove City GK **Michael Manahan** at the 64:37 mark in the second half on an assist by freshman **Brice Lott** ... Titan sophomore GK **Christopher Passione**, in net for the third time this season, picked up his first shutout of the year by making five saves ... The Titans then lost at Saint Vincent 1-0 on Saturday
