## PAC Men's Soccer Player of the Week

### GARRETT HORVATH Westminster College

Freshman midfielder

Horvath led the Titans to a 2-0 with home PAC victories over Thiel (4-0) and Bethany (3-1) last week, scoring the game-winning goals in each contest. He recorded the opening goal against the Tomcats, while adding a goal and an assist versus the Bison to give him five points on the week (two goals, one assist).

Other nominees included junior GK **Joel Gladfelter** of Grove City, and sophomore MF **Mike Seminerio** of Washington & Jefferson.

## PAC MEN'S SOCCER NOTES

### *Bethany Bison*

Bethany went 1-1 last week, with both games being PAC contests ... The Bison started the week by defeating Waynesburg on the road 1-0 for the team's fourth consecutive victory ... Junior **Lavel Williams** scored the only goal for the Bison off an assist from sophomore **Ramon Franklyn** in the 67th minute ... **Paulo Dos Santos** made four saves in the shutout ... The Bison played on the road again on Saturday at Westminster and lost, 3-1 ... The Bison goal came from sophomore **Sean Esterbauer** on a penalty kick ... It was his first goal of the season ... The squad will return to action this week with two games against W&J.

### *Wash. & Jeff. Presidents*

W&J extended its unbeaten streak to five matches with a win over Thiel and a home scoreless tie with Grove City ... Sophomore MF **Mike Seminerio** scored a pair of goals in the win over Thiel Tuesday at Alumni Stadium ... The Presidents took a 1-0 lead seven minutes into the contest on an unassisted goal by Seminerio ... Seminerio made it a 2-0 game after converting a penalty kick five minutes into the second half ... Sophomore F **Brandon Bertovich** added an insurance goal in the 63rd minute for the final margin ... Senior GK **Mike Garet** was awarded the victory for W&J after making three saves in 75 minutes of action ... Freshman GK **Cameron Lucas** played the final 15 minutes ... The Presidents outshot the Wolverines 8-5 Saturday.

### *Grove City Wolverines*

Grove City extended its unbeaten streak to six with two shutouts last week ... Grove City earned a 0-0 draw at Washington and Jefferson Saturday as **Joel Gladfelter** recorded his fourth straight shutout in goal ... The Wolverines have not allowed a goal in 396 minutes ... Last Monday, Grove City earned a 2-0 home win over La Roche ... **Nate Jones** and **Bob McNeese** each had a goal and an assist in the victory ... McNeese has 14 goals this year, the most for a Grove City player since **Greg Kreutzberg's** 25 in 1996 ... The six-match unbeaten streak is Grove City's longest since 1996, when the Wolverines closed the season with eight consecutive victories.

### *Waynesburg Yellow Jackets*

The Waynesburg College men's soccer team was shutout in a conference game for the third time this season, when it lost to Bethany 1-0 on Wednesday ... The Yellow Jackets have lost eight of their last nine games, with the lone win being a 3-1 victory over Pitt-Bradford ... The one-goal loss to the Bison was the third straight for the Jackets and fifth this season ... Four of the losses have been in PAC play ... The Jackets have gone without a goal for the last 184 minutes ... Waynesburg has been outscored 20-6 since the start of conference play.

### *Thiel Tomcats*

Thiel dropped a pair of PAC games last week, falling at home to W&J 3-0 Tuesday and 4-0 at Westminster Thursday ... Freshman GK **Ryan Lewis** posted seven saves against the Presidents and six against the Titans ... Tomcat seniors will be recognized on Tuesday prior to the Penn State Behrend match.

### *Westminster Titans*

Westminster bounced back from its first losses of the season to record PAC home wins over Thiel (4-0) and Bethany (3-1) last week ... Sophomores **Blake Ordell** and **Todd Atwood** each recorded a goal and an assist against the Tomcats, while freshman **Garrett Horvath** and sophomore **Tarik Bakir** also scored goals ... Freshman **Chris Passione** made five saves to earn the shutout in his first collegiate start ... Against the Bison, Horvath and senior **Sebastian Driver-Salazar** each posted a goal and an assist, while senior **Zach Saxman** also scored ... Passione earned the win in relief of starter **Anthony Beilstein**, making a pair of saves.
