PAC MEN'S SOCCER 2011 - Week 7 Conference Notes

TMC WINS SHOWDOWN: The highly-anticipated matchup Saturday between Thomas More and Geneva, the lone two remaining unbeaten teams in PAC play, saw the Saints prevail 2-1 at The Bank of Kentucky Field to take over sole possession of first place in the conference with two weeks to play ... Grove City moved into a second-place tie with the Golden Tornadoes following a 2-0 week that saw the Wolverines upend both Thiel (1-0) and Washington & Jefferson (4-1).

NEWS & NOTES: Junior M **Andrew Sullivan** netted the game-winning goal for Thomas More in the 31st minute of the Saints' 2-1 PAC win over Geneva Saturday ... Sophomore F **Arkangelo James** posted three of Bethany's four goals during a 1-1 week for the Bison last week ... Junior F **Anthony Balistreri** posted two goals and an assist for Saint Vincent in a 4-2 win at Waynesburg ... Washington & Jefferson head coach **Ian McDonald** needs just four wins to reach 200 for his career.

AROUND THE PAC: **Brian Wilkes** posted a goal and an assist for Grove City in a 4-1 PAC victory against Washington & Jefferson ... **Jon Mathoslah** scored the game-winning goal for Geneva in a 2-1 OT win over Bethany ... Thiel dropped its lone match of the week to Grove City 1-0 on a PK goal, marking the fifth one-goal loss of the season for the Tomcats ... Westminster suffered its first loss to Waynesburg since 2005 with a 3-0 loss, as WU freshman **Joakim Coleman** had a goal and an assist.

BC totaled a 25-6 shot advantage and Coleman recorded five saves to turn in his third clean sheet of the season.
