PAC Men's Soccer Player of the Week

MATT ROSER

Westminster College

Senior forward

Kingwood, Tex./Kingwood H.S.

Roser led Westminster to a 2-0 week with PAC wins over Bethany (2-1) and Thiel (1-0), extending the Titans' unbeaten streak to five games (4-0-1) with two late game-winning goals. He assisted on the first goal at Bethany before scoring the game-winner with 3:12 to play, then scored the only goal of the Thiel game with 1:30 left. Roser, who broke the WC career goals record last week, broke the school record for points against Bethany. He now has career records of 36 goals and 94 points, topping Jason O'Connell (92 points from 1993-96).

Other nominees included sophomore MF Lavel Williams of Bethany, sophomore GK Joel Gladfelter of Grove City, senior B Jonathan Bobanick of Thiel, and junior F Andy Komar of Washington & Jefferson.

PAC MEN'S SOCCER NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison split a pair of PAC games last week and remain in contention for a home game in the first round of the PAC Tournament... At Waynesburg and trailing with less than 10 minutes to go, senior D Zach Klipa scored just his second career goal with 7:20 to play to knot the score at 1-1 and force overtime... In the extra session, F Ryan Fiano set up M Lavel Williams for the game-winner 6:31 into the first OT as the Bison recorded their second win of the year over Waynesburg... BC nearly used the same recipe for an upset over Westminster Saturday but it was the Titans who used a late goal to pull out the 2-1 victory... Williams scored off an assist from Nick Krayvo in the 79th minute to tie the game at 1-1 but Westminster broke the tie with a score with just 3:12 remaining.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

The Presidents extended their winning streak to three matches this week after posting home victories over Thiel and Grove City ... Junior F Mike Chiodo became the school's all-time leading goal scorer on Tuesday after notching his 33rd and 34th career goals in the 6-2 win over the Tomcats ... Chiodo passed Chris Rihn '96 for the honor ... Junior F Andy Komar also notched a pair of goals for W&J, including the game winner in the 54th minute ... Komar, who has scored seven goals in his past four games, netted both W&J goals in the 2-0 shutout of Grove City ... Komar found the net on a header off an assist from junior D Nick Hovanic in the 60th minute and then scored 10 minutes later off feeds from Chiodo and freshman MF Brian Witkovitz ... Junior GK Mike Garet made three saves in posting his second shutout.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City's undefeated run in the PAC came to an end Friday at Washington and Jefferson ... The Wolverines sustained a pair of shutout losses on the road last week ... Sophomore goalkeeper Joel Gladfelter had four saves against Penn State Altoona, then stopped three shots against Washington and Jefferson ... Head coach Dr. Don Lyle has 249 career wins ... Grove City enshrined Scott Johnston (Class of 1955) and James Foraker (Class of 1958) into its Men's Soccer Hall of Fame Saturday as part of Homecoming weekend.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg is suffering a six-game losing streak after losing to Bethany in overtime last Wednesday, 2-1, in PAC action and to Lake Erie on Saturday, 1-0, in non-league play ... Nick West scored the lone goal in the Bethany game giving the Jackets a 1-0 lead ... The goal in the 73rd minute is the team's only goal in now its last five games ... The Bison scored with 7:20 left in the game, before Lavel Williams scored the game-winner in overtime ... Waynesburg was outshot, 15-5, in the game ... Against Lake Erie, Waynesburg was oushot 12-8 after giving up the game-winner in the second half.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats finished the week 1-2 overall and 0-2 in the PAC ... Thiel battled W&J to a 2-2 halftime tie, but the Presidents scored four unanswered in their 6-2 victory Tuesday ... Junior MFs Eric Hauser and Evan Knox each had a goal ... On Senior Day at Alumni Stadium on Thursday, the Tomcats shut out Lake Erie 4-0 in non-conference action ... Four different Tomcats scored in the shutout win, the team's first of the season ... Freshman F Steve Haylett tallied his team-best eighth goal of the season, giving him the most goals scored in a single season in the program's history ... The Tomcats suffered a heartbreaking 1-0 defeat at Westminster Sunday as the Titans broke the scoreless tie with 1:30 to play Senior GK David Visnicky finished with six saves in defeat.

Westminster Titans

The Titans ran their unbeaten streak to five games (4-0-1) with PAC wins at Bethany (2-1 on Saturday) and home vs. Thiel (1-0 on Sunday) ... Senior F Matt Roser posted the game-winning goals in the final minutes of both games, scoring with 3:12 left at Bethany and 1:30 left against Thiel ... Roser broke the school career points record against Bethany and now is the WC career leader in goals (36) and points (94) ... Freshman Mark Sadler scored the first goal at Bethany, assisted by Roser ... Senior D Nick White assisted on the game-winner at Bethany, while junior MF Zach Saxman assisted on the lone goal vs. Thiel ... Senior GK Kevin Humberston made six saves in the Bethany win and three saves in the shutout of Thiel, his fifth shutout of the season.
