PAC STREAKING: Bethany snapped a nine-match losing streak by hanging on for a 3-2 victory over Thiel ... Geneva moved their win streak to five games with a perfect 3-0 week with victories over W & J, Westminster and Pitt-Greensburg ... The Wolverines can clinch a berth in the PAC Championship Tournament with one more conference win or one Bethany conference loss ... Saint Vincent extended their unbeaten streak to five, defeating Westminster and tying W&J on the week.

NEWS & NOTES: As a team, Thomas More has outshot opponents 307-128, including 144-52 on goal ... Grove City outshot Bethany 27-3 in the two teams match on last Wednesday ... Washington & Jefferson is ranked in the Top 40 teams in shutout percentage and scoring offense heading into last week's games ... The Saints' **Aaron Osborne** and **Dan Miller** are ranked in the Top 15 in goals per game and assists per game respectively, while being tied for 21st in points per game.
