PAC Men's Soccer Player of the Week

Fisher tallied three goals and two assists on the week, leading Westminster to first place in the PAC with a 3-0 week and helping the Titans extend their school-record winning streak to nine games. He scored two goals and added a pair of assists in a 7-1 PAC win over Thiel, then added a goal in Westminster's 3-2 win over league rival Bethany.

Other nominees included junior MF **Daniel Reinoso** of Bethany, senior GK **Brad Smith** of Grove City, and sophomore F **Andy Komar** of Washington & Jefferson.

Bethany Bison

The Bison split a pair of PAC games last week and fell a game and a half behind Westminster for the top seed in the PAC Tournament ... In an 8-0 blanking of Waynesburg, **Daniel Reinoso** had three goals, two on PKs and two assists and Ehren Grill scored twice ... Other goals were scored by **Billy Constantine**, **Steven Wood** and **George Swann** ... The Bison outshot the Yellow Jackets 51-2 in the beating ... Bethany took a 2-0 lead against Westminster on goals by Grill and **Justin Kosta** but could not hold off a Titan rally ... It was Bethany's first-ever loss to Westminster in five meetings.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Sophomore F **Andy Komar** scored his eighth and ninth goals of the season in leading W&J to a 3-0 shutout of Grove City on Saturday afternoon at Cameron Stadium ... Sophomore F **Mike Chiodo** assisted on both Komar goals ... Freshman MF **Luis Rosales** also scored a goal on a penalty kick in the win ... Junior GK **Brad Guinn** teamed with sophomore **Mike Garet** on the shutout, making 13 stops between them ... Frostburg State edged the Presidents, 3-2, on Tuesday afternoon in a rain-filled contest in Frostburg, Md. ... W&J took a 2-1 lead in the second half on goals by Komar and sophomore F **Joe Perhacs**, but the Bobcats fought back to tie the game and scored the game winner with seven minutes remaining in regulation

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverines snapped a two-game skid with a 1-0 victory at Pitt-Bradford Wednesday afternoon ... **Nate Jones** scored the Grove City goal, his second of the season ... **Matt Johnson** had the assist while goalkeeper **Brad Smith** stopped six shots for his third shutout this year ... Win was 399th in program history and 239th for head coach **Dr. Don Lyle** ... At Washington and Jefferson, Smith stopped 10 President shots but the Wolverines were blanked for the seventh time in 2002 ... Wolverines must defeat Thiel and Washington and Jefferson in their last two conference matches to have a chance at hosting a conference quarterfinal game Nov. 4.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

After breaking a six-game losing streak last week at Grove City, Waynesburg was handed a decisive 8-0 loss against Bethany on Wednesday ... The Jackets could only manage shots by **Anthony Mariani** and **Nick West**, as Bethany outshot Waynesburg 51-2 ... Goalkeepers **Justin Fee** (31) and **Andrew Fencil** (12) combined for 43 saves ... The Jackets fall to 3-10-1 on the season and 1-6-1 in the PAC.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel went 0-2 last week, falling to PAC counterpart Westminster 7-1 on Thursday and losing 2-0 to Case Western Reserve Sunday afternoon ... Senior **Bill Douglas** tallied the Tomcats only goal of the week against the Titans in the first half of play ... Senior GK **Jeremy Rotzell** snagged eight saves in the Tomcats 2-0 loss to CWRU ... Thiel plays host to Penn State-Behrend on Thursday at 3 p.m.

Westminster Titans

Westminster broke the program record for consecutive wins this week, as the Titans went 3-0 to improve their school-record win streak to nine games, breaking the mark of eight straight wins set in 2000 ... After posting a 2-0 shutout at Penn State-Altoona on Tuesday, Westminster tightened its grip on first place in the PAC with a 7-1 win over Thiel on Thursday and a 3-2 road win at Bethany Saturday ...
