Earlier in the week, W&J handed Thomas More a 3-2 defeat in Kentucky in another key matchup ... Thiel earned its first PAC win of the season with a 2-0 shutout of Waynesburg Saturday, as sophomore M **Chad Swisher** led the Tomcats with a goal and an assist.

WHO'S HOT: Junior F Brice Lott scored the game-winning goal in Westminster's 1-0 victory over W&J ... Senior D Ryan McDonald of W&J scored a pair of goals at Thomas More, including the game-winning penalty kick in the final minute, in a 3-2 President victory ... Junior F Jon Tensing scored a pair of goals for Thomas More last week, including the game-winner in a 1-0 road win at Grove City ... Sophomore M Alex Ford's first career goal was the game-winner for Grove City in a 3-2 win at Saint Vincent.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Freshman F **Cameron Ward** scored the lone goal for Bethany in a 1-1 draw with Waynesburg, while senior M **Ronnie Wilson** tallied the lone score for the Yellow Jackets ...
