Bethany went 1-0-1 last week, including a 1-1 tie against co-PAC leader W&J ... The draw, coupled with a Grove City loss to Westminster.

clinched a berth for the Bison in the PAC Tournament ... BC trailed the Presidents 1-0 on a PK early in the second half, but evened the match in the 67th minute on a goal by **Cory Estes**, which tied him for the team-lead with six goals in just eight games played ... GK **Chad Perry** made seven saves to keep the Bison even ... Wednesday, senior **Steve Haylett** scored off a rebound from a shot by **Mike Hasson** just 23 seconds into the second half, which was enough for Bethany to claim a 1-0 win over Saint Vincent ... Perry made seven saves for his second shutout of the season.

## Saint Vincent Bearcats



The Bearcats saw their three-game unbeaten streak snapped after suffering two shutout losses on the week ... In Wednesday's 1-0 loss at Bethany, the Bison

scored the game's lone goal just seconds into the second half ... The Bearcats outshot Bethany 14-13 on the game, and posted nine shots on goal compared to five by the Bison, but were unable to find the net ... In Friday's 2-0 loss to Carnegie Mellon, the Tartans scored the decisive goal in the game's 23<sup>rd</sup> minute before adding a second tally in the final moments of the second half ... CMU outshot Saint Vincent 26-14, putting 13 shots on goal, with 11 turned aside by Bearcat GK **Brandon Bower**.
