PAC Men's Soccer Player of the Week

ALEX PENTINO - Bethany College

Junior sweeper - Wheeling, W.Va./Wheeling Park H.S.

Pentino led the Bison to a 2-0 week by keying a sterling defensive corps. His play against defending national champion Messiah (ranked #1 nationally with 5.3 gpg) helped Bethany end the Falcons' 31-game unbeaten streak with a 2-0 road shutout win.

Also nominated was senior midfielder **Sam Coffman** of Grove City and freshman forward **Mike Chiodo** of Washington & Jefferson.

Bethany Bison

Despite being outshot 27-6, Bethany went into Messiah, the #1 ranked team in the country and defending national champion, and ended the Falcons 31game unbeaten streak with a 2-0 win ... Goals by Stuart Bracher and Billy Constantine, coupled with sterling play by goalkeeper Ryann Bradley (nine saves) and the Bison defense spearheaded the upset ... The win over Messiah was Bethany's first in six attempts ... Earlier in the week, Bethany fell behind 1-0 to Waynesburg, only to score five unanswered goals to pick up the PAC win ... Constantine knocked in a pair of goals, while Brent Coffey had a goal and an assist.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J had its four-game-winning streak snapped this week with two losses at home to Frostburg State and Grove City ... The Presidents held a 1-0 lead and trailed by one with just under four minutes remaining against Frostburg State, however, the Bobcats rallied for three late goals to take the four-goal victory ... The loss to Grove City gave W&J its second overtime loss this season ... Three of W&J's seven losses this season have been one-goal defeats

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverines secured the top seed at the 2001 PAC Championship Tournament by virtue of its 2-1 overtime victory at Washington & Jefferson on Saturday ... Senior **Sam Coffman** scored the game-winner with nine seconds left in the first overtime session ... Sophomore **Justin Blakeslee** and senior **Brian Williams** were credited with the other Wolverine goals last week ... Grove City has not allowed more two goals in a game this season.
