PAC Offensive Player of the Week

BLAKE ORDELL Westminster Senior forward Clinton Twp., Mich. Fraser H.S.



Ordell posted six points (two goals and two assists) while leading Westminster to a 3-0 week. The Titans posted PAC wins over Thiel (6-0) and Thomas More (4-0) before topping non-league opponent Mount St. Joseph (1-0).

Also nominated was sophomore F Ashkan Alavy of Bethany, sophomore F Tyler Ferrier of Grove City, and freshman D Nick Munnell of Waynesburg.

Ellwanger keyed a defensive unit which posted three consecutive shutouts last week, topping PAC foes Thiel (6-0) and Thomas More (4-0) as well as Mount St. Joseph (1-0). The Titan defense held opponents to a combined 26 shots (8.7 spg), as WC keepers made just 10 saves combined (3.3 spg).

Also nominated was junior SW John Zervos of Bethany, junior GK Michael Manahan of Grove City, and senior GK Mark Coney of Thiel.

Bethany Bison

Bethany's unbeaten streak reached nine and their scoreless stretch ran to 621 minutes with two more shutouts last week ... The Bison settled for a 0-0 tie with rival W&J in a match that featured 51 fouls and seven yellow cards ... GK

Kosta Floros stopped eight shots, including four to OT, to run his personal scoreless streak to 485 minutes ... Saturday, BC scored two goals just before half in a 3-0 win over Waynesburg ... Jason Straw scored the first goal in the 41st minute off an assist from Ramon Franklyn and Andrew McPherson added a score two minutes later off a pass from Ashkan Alavy ... The final goal came from Alavy, unassisted in the 71st minute ... Chad Perry made the start in net and registered four saves to post his second win of the year and first career shutout.



Thiel Tomcats

After falling at Westminster 6-0 Tuesday, the Tomcats suffered their 13th loss of the season in a 3-0 loss to Saint Vincent last week ... Senior GK **Mark Coney** made 12 saves in the SVC loss ... Thiel finishes its 2006 season with a trip to Grove City this Tuesday to face the Wolver-

ines. They then host Washington & Jefferson on Saturday, Oct. 28.



Grove City Wolverines

Grove City charged back into contention for a berth in the PAC Tournament with a 2-0 home win over W&J Saturday ... Sophomore **Tyler Ferrier** and senior **Jonathan Mahtani** both scored second-half goals against the Prexies

... Juniors Eli Lamborn and Chad Ashby each had assists ... In goal, Michael Manahan posted his seventh shutout of the year by stopping six shots ... Wednesday, the Wolverines tied a season high with four goals in a 4-1 win at Saint Vincent ... Ashby had a goal and an assist while Bob McNees had two goals and assist against the Bearcats ... Ferrier also scored his first collegiate goal in the win ... Grove City concludes the regular season with home matches against Thiel and Thomas More ... The Wolverines will clinch a berth in the PAC Tournament with a pair of wins.



Thomas More Saints

Washington & Jefferson Presidents

The Presidents tied Bethany on Wednesday in their fifth double-overtime match of the season ... W&J holds a 1-2-2 record in those matches this year ... Sophomore GK **Tyler Hodgins** made seven saves in the tie in which W&J was outshot by a 16-11 margin ... The game featured 51 fouls and eight cards (one red) ... Grove City notched

a pair of second-half goals on Sunday to post a 2-0 victory ... W&J can clinch a spot in the PAC Tournament with a win over Thiel on Saturday or a Waynesburg loss to Westminster.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets posted a split in last week's two contests, winning in overtime against Thomas More in conference play before being shutout by Bethany, 3-0 ... Against the Saints, freshman **Nick Munnell**

scored with five minutes remaining in overtime to complete a comeback from two goals down ... The overtime win by the Yellow Jackets is their first since the 2003 season ... Junior **Todd Schollaert** posted his second career multi-goal game of his career, while senior **Scott Garet** netted his first goal of the season ... GK **Brad Davis** picked up the win after tallying five saves in net ... Against the Bison, Daivs made 11 saves on 22 shots in 90 minutes of action ... Bethany held a 22-5 shot advantage over Waynesburg Saturday.



Westminster Titans

Westminster won all three of its matches last week including a 6-0 home shutout of Thiel Tuesday and a pair of shutouts against Thomas More (4-0) and Mount St. Joseph (1-0) in Cincinnati, Ohio ... Five players each scored two goals for the Titans during the week including team-leader **Andrew Saporito** (8), **Blake Ordell** (5), **Todd Atwood** (6), **Matt Tomnay** (3) and **Brice Lott** (5) ... Atwood's two goals were the only first half goals in the 4-0 win over TMC, while one of Lott's goals was the game-winner against Mount St. Joseph in the 38th

minute on an assist from Ordell ... **Anthony Beilstein** (120 minutes) and **Christopher Passione** (150) shared goalkeeping duties to help the Titans register the three shutouts with four and six saves, respectively.
