With a pair of shutout wins last week, the Bison are now in control of their own destiny to clinch a spot in the PAC Tournament, they need a tie or win over Westminster to clinch it's first PAC Tournament berth since 2007 ... Thiel evened its record for the week with a 1-0 win over Westminster.
