PAC MEN'S SOCCER NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison came away with a loss and a draw in two outings last week ... W&J took a 2-0 lead on Bethany before freshman forward Ryan Fiano scored his fourth goal of the season to cut the deficit to 2-1 in the 54th minute ... But the Presidents put the game away with a score in the 73rd minute to sweep the season series from the Bison ... BC and La Roche battled for 110 minutes but neither team was able to dent the scoreboard as the Bison settled for their third tie of the season ... GK Adam Seifert made six saves in the match to hold the Redhawks off the board.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson extended its season-long win streak to five matches with a 3-1 victory over Bethany on Wednesday evening; however, No. 16 CMU shutout the Presidents, 3-0, on Saturday at Cameron Stadium ... In the win over the Bison, midfielders senior Matthew Pihlblad, junior Joe Perhacs and sophomore Luis Rosales all notched goals ... Junior goalie Mike Garet made three saves for W&J, which held a 19-10 advantage in shots ... Carnegie Mellon raced out to a 2-0 lead in the first 17 minutes of the game on Saturday and never looked back in blanking the Presidents ... Garet played the first half for W&J and made four saves.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City gave head coach Dr. Don Lyle his 250th career victory Saturday ... He is the 37th Division III men's soccer coach to pick up 250 career wins ... Freshman Bob McNees scored twice against Thiel while Adam Ludwig tallied a goal and an assist ... Joel Gladfelter and Dave Mahtani combined on the shutout, Grove City's fifth whitewash of the year ... The Wolverines are battling for home-field advantage in the PAC Tournament ... Grove City can clinch the top seed by defeating Waynesburg Monday and Washington and Jefferson next Saturday ... The Wolverines also held the top seed in the 2001 tournament but lost in the finals to Bethany ... The Wolverines are seeking their first PAC title since 1996.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg erased an eight-game losing streak with a 1-0 win over Westminster Saturday for its second PAC win of the year ... The Jackets' Mike Pilarski booted the game-winner on a penalty kick ... The Jackets notched their first overall win since Sept. 20 over Pitt-Bradford and first conference win since Sept. 18, a double-overtime victory against Thiel ... The goal ends the Jackets' three-game scoreless drought ... Pilarski attempted two of the Jackets four shots, while Justin Fee made six saves on eight shots ... Earlier in the week, the Jackets lost 1-0 to Seton Hill and 2-0 to Frostburg State in non-league action.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel dropped its only game last week, falling 3-0 at Grove City on Saturday ... The Wolverines outshot the Tomcats 18-6 and had a 6-3 advantage in corner kicks ... Freshman GK Mark Coney allowed a pair of goals and had four stops in the loss ... Thiel was supposed to have closed the regular season out with a pair of road games this week, but due to poor field conditions at Penn State Behrend, the game scheduled for 3 p.m. on Tuesday in Erie is going to be played at Alumni Stadium at 1:30 p.m.

Westminster Titans

The Titans saw their five-game unbeaten streak (4-0-1) snapped with a 1-0 PAC loss at Waynesburg on Saturday, followed by a 3-2 non-conference loss at Frostburg State on Sunday ... The Jackets scored the game's only goal on Saturday on a penalty kick ... Senior GK Kevin Humberston made two saves in the loss ... At FSU, the Bobcats took a 1-0 lead in the 31st minute, but Westminster rallied with a penalty kick goal by junior MF Sebastian Driver-Salazar at 33:33 and a goal by freshman F Mark Sadler at 38:06 to take a 2-1 lead ... Senior F Matt Roser assisted on the first goal, while freshman MF Sam Robinson assisted on Sadler's tally. ... The Bobcats tied the game 2-2 just before half, then posted the game-winner at 59:19 ... Humberston made three saves against Frostburg.
