PAC MEN'S SOCCER 2009 - Week 9 Conference Notes


PAC PLAYOFFS SHAPING: Heading into the last week of the regular season. Thomas More has clinched at least a share of the PAC title and the No. 1 seed for the conference tournament ... Westminster and Grove City are sitting at the No. 2 and 3 spots respectively heading into this week ... Geneva defeated Saint Vincent to extend its winning streak to six straight ... Geneva has matched its 12-game win total that was achieved in the last two years.

RAISING THE BAR: With three goals against Washington & Jefferson. Thomas More's Aaron Osborne set school records for goals (19 g, 5 a) in a season and points (43) in the season ... Saint Vincent's Luis Rodriguez scored against Grove City to give him 101 career points, making him just the fourth player in program history to record 100+ career points ... Against Geneva, Rodriguez also scored to give him his 14th career multi-goal game, and his 48 career goals are now good for third all-time in team history.

NEWS & NOTES: Grove City's Andrew Quinn scored the game-winning goal against Saint Vincent ... It represented Quinn's third straight game-winning goal for Grove City ... Waynesburg senior GK Luke Navickas picked up his first shutout of the season against the Tomcats, and totaled 10 saves in net over the two victories ... The Saints have outshot their opponents 331-143 this season, including 154-59 in shots on goal.

Freshman Andrew Quinn scored the game-winner at 69:04 ... It represented Quinn's third straight game-winning goal for Grove City ... Alex Ayer and Austin Bernal both scored goals ... Ayer's goal, his first of the season, came three minutes into the second half ... The Wolverines owned a 27-14 edge in shots ... The three goals matched a season-high for Grove City .. The Wolverines would clinch the No. 2 seed in the PAC Championship Tournament with a win at Westminster Saturday ... Grove City hosts Fredonia State in non-league action Wednesday in the 2009 home finale.

Saint Vincent Bearcats (7-10-2)

The Bearcats had a tough 0-2 week, dropping a pair of one-goal contests that were both

decided in the closing minutes ... Jim Vargo and Luis Rodriguez were the goal scorers for SVC at Grove City on Wednesday, with Vargo's goal his first of the season, and Rodriguez's score giving him 101 career points, making him just the fourth player in program history to record 100+ career points ... On Saturday against Geneva, Rodriguez scored a pair of goals in the opening 20 minutes, but Geneva stormed back with three unanswered, including the game-winner with 5:40 remaining in regulation ... Clemente Mejia made 19 saves in goal in the two defeats, including a career-high 11 stops at Grove City.

Thiel Tomcats (5-12-1, 0-6 PAC)

Westminster defeated Thiel,

3-0, in men's soccer action Wednesday afternoon at Alumni Stadium ... On Saturday, Thiel dropped its sixth consecutive conference game in the form of a 0-1 loss to the Waynesburg University Yellow Jackets ...
