PAC Men's Soccer Player of the Week

MIKE CHIODO Washington & Jefferson College

Sophomore forward Carnegie, Pa./Chartiers Valley H.S.

Chiodo earned his second PAC Player of the Week award this season after scoring three goals and adding two assists while leading the Presidents to a 2-0 week with wins over PAC rival Bethany (3-1) and Pitt-Bradford (6-1). He assisted the game's first goal and added a later goal against the Bison, then tallied a pair of scores and an assist in the first nine minutes of the UP-B win.

Other nominees included junior MF **Daniel Reinoso** of Bethany, senior GK **Brad Smith** of Grove City, and sophomore MF **John Booth** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

The Bison rebounded from a loss at W&J with a 2-1 victory over LaRoche Saturday ... In the setback in Washington, Bethany fell behind 2-0 but cut the deficit in half on a goal by **Ehren Grill**, but that was as close as the Bison would get as Bethany fell to third place in the league ... In the LaRoche triumph, **Daniel Reinoso** scored both goals, with assists coming from **Mike Walters** and **Dan Irwin** ... Senior **Ryann Bradley** made eight saves in the win, as Bethany outshot the hosts 30-10.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J has won six of its last seven games and is currently riding a two-game win streak ... The Presidents picked up their second-ever victory over Bethany in 37 chances on Wednesday by a 3-1 margin ... The Presidents now hold a 2-1-2 advantage over the Bison in the past two seasons ... Freshman Luis Rosales notched a pair of goals in the win, while sophomore Mike Chiodo added a late insurance goal ... Sophomore GK Brad Guinn made seven saves ... W&J trounced Pitt-Bradford, 6-1, on Sunday ... Chiodo scored two goals and assisted on another score in the first nine minutes ... Senior John Lowenhaupt assisted on two goals in the win, while sophomore **Andy Komar** added one goal and one assist.

Grove City Wolverines

The Wolverines dropped a 2-0 decision to undefeated Carnegie Mellon last Tuesday at College Field ... Goalkeeper **Brad Smith** made seven saves for the Wolverines ... Grove City visits Thiel Monday afternoon before trekking to Penn State Altoona Wednesday ... Grove City can still earn a home quarterfinal game in the PAC tournament with wins over Thiel and Nov. 2 over Washington and Jefferson.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

A second half goal by **Matt Elban** gave Waynesburg a 1-1 tie with Seton Hill on Tuesday ... Elban's goal came in the 16-minute mark of the second half on a Nick West assist ... **Justin Fee** stopped 11 shots for the Jackets in goal ... After a 2-0 loss to Penn State-Altoona on Thursday, the Jackets returned to PAC action on Saturday with a 3-1 loss to Westminster ... **Will Pradera** scored the lone goal for the Jackets, while Fee registered 15 saves.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel dropped its only game last week, falling to non-conference opponent Penn State Behrend 2-1 ... With the game locked at 1-1 and both teams looking towards overtime, a penalty shot was awarded to PSB with no time remaining on the clock, giving the Lions the 2-1 win ... 43 fouls were whistled between the two teams ... Junior Jason Kolos tied the game at 1-1 when he corralled a shot by freshman Takuma Kaneko that deflected off of the crossbar and drilled in past the outstretched PSB keeper ... The Tomcats host their final two conference games this week, with Grove City coming to Alumni Stadium on Monday and Waynesburg on Saturday.

Westminster Titans

Westminster clinched the top seed for the PAC men's soccer tournament last week with a 3-1 road win at Waynesburg in the team's only contest ... The other game scheduled against Lake Erie was cancelled by the opponent due to a lack of players ... The win over the Jackets extended the Titans' schoolrecord winning streak to 10 games ... Westminster got second half goals by freshman F Anthony Makuch-Lott (off an assist by senior MF Josh Hanna), sophomore MF John Booth (unassisted), and junior F Todd Fisher (off an assist by Matthew Roser) ... Sophomore Rick Walker started in goal and made one first half save before giving way to senior Kevin Humberston, who had one second half save.
