Bethany (1-2-1) can climb into the PAC tournament with road wins over W&J and Thomas More, while Waynesburg is still mathematically alive for the final slot.

WHO'S HOT: Luis Rodriguez scored both Saint Vincent goals, including the game-winner in the 108th minute, of a 2-1 double-overtime victory for the Bearcats at Thomas More ... Bruce Fox and Josh Mann each scored a pair of goals for Geneva in a 4-2 road PAC win at Waynesburg ... Junior F Joey Tensing scored both goals for 1-1 Thomas More last week, including the gamewinner in a 1-0 victory at Geneva ... W&J's Mike Pappas scored the game-winning goal in the 97th minute of a 2-1 PAC win at Thiel.
