Bethany Bison



The Bison split a pair of matches last week, knocking off Thomas More 3-2 before falling at Geneva 6-0 ... BC fell behind early to the Saints but rallied to take a 2-1 lead behind goals from **Chatham Gongola** and **Cory Estes** ... TMC would tie the match, but **Jason Straw** scored with just 1:40 left in regulation to give BC the victory ... The win helped secure Bethany the third-seed for this week's PAC Tournament, as they will take on #2 W&J Wednesday night in the semifinals ... The Bison beat the Presidents 1-0 in OT on a **Telly Mantziouras** goal in last year's PAC semifinals, which ended W&J's three-game winning streak over Bethany in PAC Tournament play.

Saint Vincent Bearcats



The Bearcats went 2-0 on the final week of the season ... In Tuesday's 4-0 win over Thiel, **Ben Fecik** notched two goals, while **Sean Molyneaux** and **Luis Rodriguez** scoring one apiece ... Rodriguez added an assist, as did **Matt Fecik**, while **Brandon Bower** made five saves for the shutout ... Washington & Jefferson Presidents



Washington & Jefferson concluded its regular season with a 9-0-2 record in its final 11 matches ... The Presidents upset Division II Wheeling Jesuit on Saturday, 1-0, behind a **Sean Park** goal with three minutes remaining ... Senior D **Zach Williams** recorded his sixth assist of the season on the goal ... The win was the first for the Presidents over Wheeling Jesuit since 1986 ... Senior **Mitchell Riehle**, junior **Jeremy Delmaster** and sophomore **Dan Hart** all scored goals for the Presidents in the win over Waynesburg ...
