The Bison ran their unbeaten streak to 10 and wrapped up the top seed and hosting rights for the PAC Tournament with a 2-0 triumph over Westminster ... A goal by **Sean Esterbauer** off a double assist from **Teli Mantziouras** and

Ramon Franklyn in the 24th minute put the Bison ahead and Esterbauer added an insurance goal in the 65th minute off an assist from Marc Auger ... GK Kosta Floros made five saves in the victory to run his personal scoreless streak to 570 minutes ... It was also the team's seventh consecutive shutout, setting a new school record ... The shutout of Westminster also means Bethany did not allow a goal in six PAC contests, the first time in conference history a team went through the regular season without surrendering at least one goal in league action.



Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats closed the 2006 season with losses to Grove City and Washington & Jefferson ... They lost to Grove City on Oct. 24, 6-0, before falling to Washington & Jefferson, 5-0 ... Senior GK **Mark Coney** made 16 saves in two contests last week, 13 in the W&J loss.
