## PAC Men's Soccer Player of the Week

### NIKOLA VASILEV Thiel College

Freshman forward Varna, Bulgaria/First Language School

Vasilev set a new Thiel single-game record by scoring all four goals in a 5-4 PAC loss to Waynesburg, which was also a single-game high in the PAC this season. He also broke the Thiel single season records for goals (14) and points (30) against the Jackets.

Other nominees included sophomore F **Bob McNees** of Grove City, senior MF **Brad Cherry** of Washington & Jefferson, sophomore MF **David Peters** of Waynesburg, and senior D **Zach Saxman** of Westminster.

### **Bethany Bison**

Bethany lost both of its games last week, at Geneva and at home against Westminster ... With the loss to Westminster, the Bison finish in fourth place in the PAC during the regular season and will host Thiel at home on Monday at 3 p.m. ... In the first game of the week, sophomore Brian Bajek scored an unassisted goal in the 44th minute to give the Bison a 1-0 lead ... Geneva came back to tally two second half goals to steal the victory ... Against Westminster, the Titans didn't take long to score, notching a goal just 2:38 into the game ... BC goalie Paulo Dos Santos made eight saves in the contest as Westminster out-shot Bethany, 19-11.

### Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J split a pair of conference matches last week, beating Thiel at home before falling at Grove City ... With the split, W&J is the No. 3 seed for the PAC Tournament and will host Waynesburg in the first round ... Senior MF Brad Cherry scored one goal and added two assists in the win over the Tomcats ... Senior F Mike Chiodo started the scoring just over four minutes in as he collected Cherry's shot attempt and scored ... The Presidents upped their lead in the 34th minute as freshman reserve F Mitchell Riehle scored on a bicycle kick in front of the net ... Cherry and Chiodo assisted on the goal ... Cherry ended the scoring with a goal on a penalty kick with seven minutes left ... Senior goalie Mike Garet notched three saves for W&J.

## PAC MEN'S SOCCER NOTES

#### Grove City Wolverines

Grove City wrapped up the No. 2 seed in this week's PAC Tournament with a 4-0 triumph over W&J Saturday ... The win extended Grove City's PAC unbeaten streak to seven (6-0-1) ... Bob McNees scored twice and adden an assist in the win while Ben Hoffman had a goal and an assist against the Presidents ... Senior Peter Willliams added his second goal of the season in the victory ... The match featured five yellow cards and two disgualifications ... Grove City earned its 10th shutout in 19 matches this season ... Wednesday, Adam Ludwig scored twice to help the Wolverines nip Waynesburg, 3-2 ... Ludwig's first goal came on a penalty kick, his second straight match with a PK goal.

### Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

It was a long month for the Waynesburg College men's soccer team ... That's how long it has been between victories for the Yellow Jackets, but the team showed it could compete in the PAC as it won 5-4 in its regular season finale vs. Thiel ... The five Jacket goals are more than the team scored in its last five games combined ... Prior to the win over the Tomcats, the last win for Waynesburg was on Sept. 18 against Pitt-Bradford ... Sophomore MF David Peters recorded a career-high five points in the victory ... Peters also set a career-high with three assists in the game, while he netted his first goal of the season ... Luke Benton netted two goals in the victory, while Dave Thorn and Todd Schollaert added goals for the Jackets.

### Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats dropped their final two PAC games of the season last week, losing at W&J 3-0 on Wednesday before suffering a 5-4 setback at Waynesburg Friday

... Thiel freshman F **Nikola Vasilev** scored each of the Tomcats four goals in the loss to the Yellow Jackets, becoming the first Thiel player to score four goals in a game ... He also became the school's singleseason goals leader with 14 and points leader with 30.

### Westminster Titans

Westminster posted a 1-1 week, including a season-ending 2-0 league win at Bethany which clinched the top seed and home field advantage for the Titans through this week's PAC Tournament ... The Titans dropped a 3-1 non-league decision at Carnegie Mellon Tuesday, as senior D Zach Saxman scored off an assist by senior MF Sebastian Driver-Salazar ... In the win over the Bison, Saxman assisted on the first goal by sophomore F Mark Sadler in the third minute, then added an insurance tally assisted by freshman M Garrett Horvath in the second half ... Freshman GK Chris Passione made four saves in the shutout victory for Westminster.
