PAC TOURNAMENT: W&J finished with an undefeated and untied record in the PAC for the first time in school history thanks to two PAC victories ... Grove City earned the No. 2 seed by beating Thomas More Saturday 2-0 ... Bethany clinched the No. 3 seed and its first berth in the PAC Tournament since 2007 with a 2-0 victory over Westminster in their regular season finale Wednesday ... Defending PAC champion Thomas More has the No. 4 seed ... Grove City will host Bethany in the conference semifinals Tuesday at 2 p.m. ... Thomas More will travel to Wash. & Jeff. on Tuesday to play in the other semifinal game at 6 p.m.

NEWS & NOTES: Grove City's **Jake Kern** scored the game-winner against Thomas More and added an assist on a goal from **Chuck Witt**, while **Alex Ayer** assisted Kern's goal ... Thiel's **Cory Borland** tallied a goal and an assist to give the Tomcats the victory over Waynesburg ... Coming on the heels of a 2-1 win at Waynesburg, Geneva got goals from **Caleb Musselman** and **Josh Mann** to turn away Saint Vincent ... Bethany put their match with Westminster away with a goal by **Tomas Gonzalez** in the 77th min. off an assist from **Arkangelo James** ...
