#### PAC MEN'S SOCCER 2009 - Week 10 Conference Notes



After losing seven of eight games, Westminster rifled through PAC play by winning its third and fourth straight PAC games this week ... Geneva, finishing 15-4 overall, qualifies for a spot in the NCCAA regional tournament and holds onto the possibility of hosting at least one post-season bout.


NEWS & NOTES: Of the conference-record 23 PAC soccer players selected, 10 men's players were named to CoSIDA/ESPN *The Magazine* Academic All-District soccer team ... W&J's Dan Hart dished out a career-high three assists vs. Thiel, giving him a team-best eight assists this season ... SVC's Luis Rodriguez ended the season as the team's leading scorer with 34 points (15g, 4a) ... He finished his career fourth all-time in program history with 105 points and third in career goals with 47.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Bethany GK Patrick Coleman stopped 13 shots and finished the season with 115, 4th-most in BC single-season history ... Saint Vincent F Ben Fecik finished the season with 11 goals and 11 assists, and was named 2nd-team CoSIDA/ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District, the first player in the history of the Bearcat soccer program to receive such an honor ... Westminster's Ian Hill now has a team-high 10 goals on the year after scoring against Grove City this week.

Saturday, Grove City fell to Westminster, 3-0 ... The Wolverines went 6-4 over the final 10 matches of the season after a 2-5-1 start ... Four Grove City players earned Academic All-District: Austin Bernal. Brian Eckenhoff. Joel Metz and Witt.
