PAC Men's Soccer Player of the Week

ANTHONY MAKUCH-LOTT Westminster College Freshman forward Abilene, Tex./Cooper H.S.

Makuch-Lott posted four goals and an assist in three games last week, leading the Titans to a 3-0 week with shutout wins over PAC rival Bethany (4-0), Penn State-Behrend (3-0) and Pitt-Bradford (6-0). He had a goal and an assist against Bethany, added the final goal in the PS-B win and had two scores against UP-B, as Westminster closed the regular season with a school-record 13 consecutive wins.

Other nominees included freshman MF **Nate Jones** of Grove City, junior MF **Jason Kolos** of Thiel, and sophomore F **Andy Komar** of Washington & Jefferson.

Bethany Bison

The Bison dropped their final two regular season games last week and enter this week's PAC Tournament having lost six of their final eight matches ... The game with Westminster was knotted at 0-0 at halftime but the Titans exploded for four second half goals to wrap up the top seed for the Tournament ... Pitt-Greensburg (18-1) took a 4-0 lead before Bethany finally scored late in the game on a goal by Justin Kosta ... Bethany has won 22 consecutive PAC titles, but face an uphill climb to extend that streak ... The Bison open the Tournament at home against Waynesburg, who Bethany has outscored 13-1 in two matches this season.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J opened the week with a tough 3-2 loss at No. 19 Carnegie Mellon on Wednesday ... CMU jumped out to a 3-0 first-half lead only to fight back to cut the lead to 3-2 with 26 minutes left after goals by junior F Tom Cameron and sophomore MF Brad Cherry ... The Tartans then held the Presidents without a shot over the last 15 minutes in recording the one-goal victory ... Sophomore F's Andy Komar and Mike Chiodo each netted a pair of goals in a 4-1 rout of Grove City on Saturday ... Komar scored two goals against the Wolverines for the second time this season ... W&J earned a first-round bye for the PAC Tournament as the No. 2 seed and hosts the winner of Bethany-Waynesburg on Wednesday at 7 pm at Cameron Stadium.

PAC MEN'S SOCCER NOTES

Grove City Wolverines

Wolverines earned the fourth seed in this week's conference tournament ... Grove City's match at Penn State Altoona Wednesday night never materialized as game officials deemed the field unplayable minutes before the opening whistle ... **Nate Jones** had a goal and two assists for Grove City against Thiel while **Mike Koper** scored Grove City's goal against W&J ... The Wolverines swept the season series from Thiel with two one-goal triumphs.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg surrendered four goals on six shots on net, as Thiel ran away with 4-0 PAC win on Saturday ... The Tomcats outshot the Jackets 14-4, while Thiel scored three of its four goals in the first half ... Waynesburg opponents have outscored the Jackets 25-2 in the last six games, including Tuesday's non-conference home loss to Pitt-Greensburg, 7-0 ... The Jackets' record drops to 3-14-2 on the season ... Waynesburg enters the PAC Tournament as the six seed with a record of 1-8-1, and will play at Bethany on Monday.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats split a pair of conference matches last week, losing to Grove City 3-2 Monday and shutting out Waynesburg 4-0 Saturday ... Thiel senior Floyd Snyder tied the game at 2-2 with just under 18 minutes remaining in regulation, but Grove City's Dustin King hit the game-winner at 74:23 ... Jason Kolos scored twice in Thiel's 4-0 win over Waynesburg on Senior Day ... Senior GK Jeremy Rotzell and junior David Visnicky combined for a two save shutout ... Kolos currently leads the Tomcats with six goals and one assist for 13 points ... The fifth-seeded Tomcats will travel to Grove City to take on the fourth-seeded Wolverines Monday at 3 p.m. in the PAC Championship Tournament.

Westminster Titans

Westminster enters the PAC Tournament as the top seed, earning a first round bye and homefield advantage throughout the tournament ... The Titans posted shutouts of PAC rival Bethany (4-0), Penn State-Behrend (3-0) and Pitt-Bradford (6-0) to end the regular season with a school-record 13-game winning streak ... The win over the Bison secured a perfect 10-0 PAC mark for the Titans ... Westminster has outscored its opponents 47-5 with nine shutouts during the streak ... Five Titans have scored at least 15 points this year: junior F Matthew Roser (9-8-26), sophomore MF John Booth (10-6-26), junior F Todd Fisher (8-7-23), freshman F Anthony Makuch-Lott (10-2-22) and senior MF Tony Arrigo (5-5-15).
