PAC Men's Soccer Player of the Week

Washington & Jefferson College

Junior forward

Carnegie, Pa./Chartiers Valley H.S.

Chiodo became the all-time leading point scorer in W&J history by scoring the team's first goal in its 2-1 overtime win over Grove City, which gave the presidents the top seed for this week's PAC Tournament. He scored his 35th career goal on a penalty kick in the fourth minute against GCC and now has 89 career points (35 G, 19 A).

Other nominees included senior MF Jimmy Hershner of Bethany, junior MF Peter Williams of Grove City, junior MF Eric Hauser of Thiel, and senior F Todd Fisher of Westminster.

PAC MEN'S SOCCER NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison went 0-1-1 last week to close out the regular season ... Bethany surrendered a goal 17 seconds into the Westminster match but rebounded with a Damien Sanzotti goal just three minutes later... The two teams then went the next 96 minutes without a goal and the Bison were forced to settle for their fourth tie of the season ... In the Pitt-Greensburg loss, Adam Zeleznick tallied a hat trick in the first half to sink the Bison on Senior Day ... Midfielder Jimmy Hershner scored his fourth goal of the season in the second half but it wasn't enough ... The Bison will host Waynesburg on Tuesday in the PAC Tournament Quarterfinals... The Yellow Jackets are the only team BC has defeated this season (5-0 and 2-1 in OT).

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson, which has won six out of its last seven matches, defeated Grove City, 2-1, in overtime on Saturday to clinch the No. 1 seed for this week's PAC Tournament ... Junior forward Andy Komar scored the game winner six minutes into the first overtime period as he headed home a free kick from sophomore defender Andrew Enrietti ... Junior forward Mike Chiodo scored the first W&J goal in the fourth minute on a penalty kick ... On the goal, Chiodo became the all-point scoring leader at Washington & Jefferson with 89 career points (35 g, 19 a) ... Junior goalie Mike Garet earned his eighth win of the season by stopping eight shots in the net ... Garet lowered his GAA to 1.06 in the victory ... The Presidents are outscoring opponents, 19-9, in the second half this season.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City earned a quarterfinal bye in this week's PAC Tournament ... The Wolverines are seeking their first-ever conference tournament championship ... Senior Mike Koper returned to the lineup Saturday after missing seven matches ... He scored Grove City's lone goal after a corner kick from Peter Williams ... Williams scored his first goal of the season at La Roche while Adam Ludwig's penalty kick goal gave Grove City the lead late in the second half ... Grove City earned its sixth shutout of the year at Waynesburg ... Grove City has not allowed a goal at Waynesburg since 1999 ... The Wolverines will host a PAC semifinal Thursday afternoon ... Grove City is 2-1 all-time at home in PAC Tournament matches.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Despite tying first-place Grove City on Monday, 0-0, Waynesburg remained in fifth place in the PAC with a loss at home to Thiel on Saturday, 2-0 ... The Jackets also lost a 6-0 non-conference game at Pitt-Greensburg on Wednesday ... In a scoreless tie with the Wolverines, Justin Fee registered his fifth shutout of the season, the second in the last two games, while making 16 saves in net for Waynesburg ... The Wolverines out-shot the Jackets, 19-9 ... UPG out-shot the Jackets 28-3, while against the Tomcats, the team tied with nine shots apiece ... Waynesburg, as the fifth seed, will now travel to Bethany for a quarterfinal game in the PAC Tournament.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcats went 1-1 last week, falling to non-conference Penn State Behrend 2-0 before picking up a 2-0 shutout win at Waynesburg on Saturday ... Tuesday's game against PSB was scheduled to be played in Erie, but due to poor field conditions, the game was moved to Thiel's Alumni Stadium ... Freshman GK Mark Coney made 10 second-half saves for the Tomcats against PSB ... Coney recorded his first collegiate shutout at Waynesburg, finishing with five saves in the win ... Junior MF Eric Hauser scored both Tomcat goals on Saturday, giving him six on the season.

Westminster Titans

The Titan kickers closed the 2003 regular season with a 1-1 double-overtime tie against PAC rival Bethany College on Wednesday ... Westminster posted its quickest goal of the year to open the game, as senior F Todd Fisher found the back of the net just 17 seconds into the contest off assists by junior MF Sebastian Driver-Salazar and senior F Matt Roser for a 1-0 Titan lead ... However, the Bison answered minutes later with a goal at the 3:55 mark by Damien Sanzotti to knot the game at 1-1 ... Westminster senior GK Kevin Humberston went the distance in goal, making nine saves in 110 minutes in the tie ... Westminster will be the #3 seed and will host #6 Thiel in a PAC first round game Tuesday ... The Titans are defending PAC champions.
