TOURNAMENT TIME: The 2008 PAC Men's Soccer Championship Tournament gets underway this week with three contest to determine the receipient of the PAC's automatic bid to the NCAA Division III playoffs ... #3 seed Thomas More travels to #2 W&J Tuesday at 5 p.m., while #4 Grove City heads to top-seeded Westminster at 8 p.m. ... The championship contest will be Saturday at the highest remaining seed, with the game time to be announced on Wednesday. WHO'S HOT: Luis Rodriguez ended the 2008 season as the leading scorer for Saint Vincent with 31 points (14 goals, three assists) ... Thomas More senior GK Matt Koopman has played 1235:44 in goal and has given up only nine goals (0.66 gaa) this season ... Grove City sophomore F Jake Kern posted a goal and an assist in a 4-1 win over Geneva Saturday ... W&J closed the regular season with PAC wins over Bethany and Waynesburg, as W&J begins defense of its 2007 PAC title.

AROUND THE LEAGUE: Freshman M James Gross scored the lone goal for Westminster in a 1-0 PAC win over Grove City Tuesday ... Bethany senior F Andrew McPherson scored the lone goal for the Bison in a 2-1 overtime PAC loss at Thomas More ... Geneva GK David Callahan posted his third shutout of the season in a 3-0 GT victory over Thiel ... Sophomore Ryan Gaudy scored the lone goal for Waynesburg as the Yellow Jackets dropped a 2-1 decision to Washington & Jefferson Saturday.
