PAC MEN'S SOCCER NOTES

Bethany Bison

The Bison scored four second half goals to run away from Westminster in a 5-1 victory ... Forward **Stuart Bracher** and midfielder **Dan Irwin** had a goal and assist each in the win ... Despite outshooting W&J 32-13, Bethany was forced to settle for a 1-1 tie with the Presidents ... The only goal was scored by **Daniel Reinoso**, with assists by **Mike Walters** and **Ricky Oliver** ... Keeper **Ryann Bradley** made six saves in the tie..

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

W&J finished the week with a 2-0-1 record after defeating two AMCC opponents (Pitt-Greensburg, Pitt-Bradford) and tying Bethany, 1-1 ... The tie vs. Bethany clinched the No. 2 seed in next weekend's PAC Tournament for the Presidents ... Freshman forward **Mike Chiodo** scored a career-high four goals against Pitt-Bradford (all in 2nd half) to lead W&J to a come-from-behind win ... The four goals in a game is a record at W&J ... Chiodo also broke the record for goals in one season by a President and now stands with 15 goals with at least two games to play ... W&J also set a team record for goals in a season (44) with five vs. UPB, breaking the old mark of 42.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City placed second in the PAC after a fourth-place showing last year ... The 13 victories mark the second-highest total in school history ... Ten of the 13 wins were decided by a shutout margin ... In the PAC championship game, senior left wing **Jon Veschio** gave the Wolverines a 1-0 halftime lead with his second goal of the season.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg fell 2-1 to Juniata and 1-0 to Westminster last week ... **Nick Kopach** scored the team's lone goal of the week versus Juniata ... The loss to Westminster is the Jackets' sixth 1-0 loss of the season.

Thiel Tomcats

Thiel fell to 2-17 with losses to Hiram (3-1) and Penn State-Behrend (6-1) last week.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster men's soccer team went 2-2 in a busy week, falling to Allegheny (2-1 in overtime) and Bethany (5-1) before topping Waynesburg (1-0) and Penn State-Altoona (6-1) ... The Titan kickers have tied the school-record for win in a season with 14, originally set last year (14-4-1) ... The Titans finished 7-3 against PAC opponents this season ... Junior MF **B.J. Mathieu** scored the lone goal in the win over Waynesburg, while senior GK **James Houser** earned his sixth shutout win of the season against the Yellow Jackets ... Westminster will host NCAA D-I Duquesne on Nov. 6 at 3 p.m., replacing a game cancelled due to the terrorist attacks.
