PRESIDENTS' ATHLETIC CONFERENCE (PAC) 2011 MEN'S SOCCER CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT - Nov. 2-5, 2011

Semifinal #1 - Wednesday, November 2

#1 THOMAS MORE 3, #4 Bethany 1

Thomas More College - Crestview Hills, Ky. - 2 p.m.

The top-seeded Saints and fourth-seeded Bison, after playing a scoreless first half, posted a flurry of goals with three goals in a span of 2:51 early in the second period. Thomas More opened the scoring on a goal by senior M **Alex Oeswein (Louisville, KY/DuPont Manual H.S.)** from 20 yards out on a free kick at 62:40. Bethany responded immediately to tie the game 1-1 just 1:09 later on an unassisted goal by sophomore F **Arkangelo James (Pittsburgh, PA/Baldwin H.S.)**. TMC then regained the lead for good at the 65:31 mark, as senior M **Alex Bertke (Cincinnati, OH/Elder H.S.)** took a feed from Oeswein and found the back of the net for a 2-1 Saint advantage. Thomas More then added an insurance tally at 74:41 on an unassisted goal by freshman M **Dexter Morgan (Covington, KY/Scott H.S.)**. TMC held a 25-6 shot advantage over the Bison, as well as a 9-2 margin in corner kicks. Senior GK **Zack Lawson (Frankfort, KY, Frankfort H.S.)** made one save for the victors, while senior GK **Patrick Coleman (South Park, PA/South Park H.S.)** made 10 stops in defeat for Bethany.

#2 GENEVA 1, #3 Grove City 0

Geneva College - Beaver Falls, Pa. - 7 p.m.

The Golden Tornadoes advanced to the PAC finals in their first season of eligibility, as Geneva scored the game-winning tally with just under 12 minutes remaining in regulation. The lone score was scored for the GTs by junior M **Jeb Nash (Bolingbrook, IL/Timothy Christian H.S.)**, who found the back of the net off a feed by senior F **Austin Petrie (Pipersville, PA/Plumstead Christian H.S.)** at 78:03. Geneva held sizeable advantages in both shots (14-6) and corner kicks (7-1) against the Wolverines. Freshman GK **Bryan Butler (Millers-**

ville, MD/Annapolis Christian H.S.) made a pair of saves in goal to secure the shutout for Geneva, while Grove City junior GK **Caleb Koch (Gaithersburg, MD/Col. Zadok Magruder H.S.)** stopped five GT shots in the loss.

PAC Championships - Friday, November 4

#1 THOMAS MORE 3, #2 Geneva 2 (ot)

Thomas More College - Crestview Hills, Ky. - 3 p.m.

Trailing 2-0 with under 30 minutes to play in regulation, the top-seeded Saints rolled off three unanswered goals to edge the upset-minded Golden Tornadoes in overtime and clinch their third consecutive PAC men's soccer title. Geneva took a 1-0 lead into halftime on a goal by junior M **Jeb Nash (Bolingbrook, IL/Timothy Christian H.S.)**, off an assist by senior F **Austin Petrie (Pipersville, PA/Plumstead Christian H.S.)** at the 27:39 mark. The GTs built the lead to 2-0 and appeared in control on an unassisted goal by senior F **Josh Mann (Colorado Springs, CO/Evangelical Christian H.S.)** just over nine minutes into the second half. TMC halved the lead to 2-1 on a goal by senior D **Keith Kreidenweis (Cincinnati, OH/Elder H.S.)** off an assist from freshman F **Alec Robbins (Taylor Mill, KY/Scott H.S.)** at 62:26. Geneva held onto the one-goal lead until just 2:43 left in regulation, when Saint senior D **Nick Brohas (Centerville, OH/Centerville H.S.)** headed in the game-tying goal off an assist by freshman D **Alex Dean (Fort Thomas, KY/Highlands H.S.)** to knot the score 2-2. In the first extra session, Robbins came away with the game- and PAC-winning goal 5:43 into overtime, scoring off a feed by senior F **Ricky Barria (Erlanger, KY/Dixie Heights H.S.)**. Thomas More posted a 21-10 shot advantage over Geneva also posted a 6-2 margin in corner kicks over the GTs. TMC senior GK **Zack Lawson (Frankfort, KY, Frankfort H.S.)** made five saves in the win, while Geneva freshman GK **Bryan Butler (Millersville, MD/Annapolis Christian H.S.)** stopped six shots.
