Grove City Wolverines

Grove City opens the 2006 season at Mount Union March 14 ... The Wolverines open conference play two days later at Bethany ... The home opener is March 27 against Thiel ... Head coach Joe Walters has 286 career wins

as men's tennis coach and 297 overall tennis coaching wins, including an 11-1 mark as women's coach in 2004 ... Grove City has won 15 straight PAC titles ... The Wolverines return four veterans, including seniors Brent Moon and Sam Fortna, and sophomores Chris Baker and Matt Hearn ... Moon is the defending PAC Player of the Year.

Thomas More Saints

Junior Michael Selm led Thomas More to a season-opening non-conference win Saturday over Berea. 5-4 ... Selm

won his first singles match 6-0, 6-0, then teamed with senior John Burwinkle to win first doubles ... The match wasn't decided until the duo of sophomore Terence Toone and freshman Alfred Minor claimed third doubles 8-7 (9-7) ... Freshman Ryan Thompson won in fourth singles, and Burwinkle added a fifth singles win ... The Saints will return to action March 13 with they travel to Danville, KY to face Maryville, TN on the Centre College campus.



Washington & Jefferson Presidents

Washington & Jefferson opened its 2006 season this past week with losses to Slippery Rock and Westminster ... Against Slippery Rock, sophomore **Jeff Tomaino** was the only President to take a match into three sets before falling to Jon Crossley ... Tomaino and senior Gary Tan both notched singles victories versus the Titans ... Tan

knocked off Josh Zapf at No. 1 singles, 10-4, while Tomaino garnered a 10-3 win over Ryan Mistovich at the No. 2 position ... The duo combined for W&J's lone win in doubles play at the No. 1 position after posting an 8-3 triumph over Zapf and Mistovich ... W&J is idle this week, but returns to action on Wednesday, March 15 at Seton Hill.



Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg split a pair of closely-played matches to open the season, as the Yellow Jackets posted a 5-4 win at Penn State-Behrend in Erie on Feb. 25 before falling 5-4 at incoming PAC member Saint Vincent on Feb. 28 ... Juniors Matt Otis and Bryan McAnulty were both double winners against PS-B, as did classmate Joe Koch

... Koch also posted a pair of wins against the Bearcats, while McAnulty captured second singles and freshman Drew Slater won at sixth singles.



Westminster Titans

The Titan netters opened the 2006 campaign last week with non-league wins at Pitt-Greensburg (5-4)and vs. W&J (6-3) ... Westminster split the six singles matches and won two of three doubles contests at UP-G ... Leading the way was senior Tyler Lonigro, who captured both first singles and first doubles with classmate Josh Zapf ... Also posting victories were sophomore Gene Cunningham and freshman Stefan Hadricky at fourth and fifth singles, respectively, as well as the third doubles team of senior Ryan Mistovich and freshman
