The Yellow Jackets bounced back with a 6-3 win over St. Vincent Tuesday after losing their spring opener to PS-Behrend, 7-2, Saturday ... The win over the Bearcats was the first of the season for Waynesburg, who competed in one fall match ... Sophomore **Matt Otis** remained perfect in singles play this season after winning his No. 1 singles match against St. Vincent in three sets (1-6, 6-4, 6-4) ... Seniors **Nate Smucker** and **Adam Fuoss** posted multiple victories against the Bearcats ... Smucker won his match at No. 5 singles in straight sets (6-0, 6-2) and teamed with classmate **Ryan Floyd** at No. 2 doubles to record an 8-5 victory ... Fuoss posted a three-set victory at No. 6 singles and earned a doubles victory with sophomore **Joe Koch** at No. 3.

Westminster Titans

The Titan netters went 2-1 to open the 2005 season, sandwiching wins over Marietta (8-1) and Pitt-Greensburg (9-0) around a 9-0 loss at Penn St.-Behrend ... Four Titans were double winners against the Pioneers, led by the senior duo of **Sam Seo** and **Dave Molitor** at #1 and #2 singles, respectively, while also teaming for victory at #1 doubles ... Juniors **Ben Libert** and **Bryan Gesinski** teamed at #2 doubles while also capturing #3 and #4 singles, respectively ... At UP-G, Westminster had six players posted double wins ... In addition to the Seo/Molitor combo, Libert (#3) teamed with frosh **Gene Cunningham** (#5) at #3 doubles, while Bryan (#4) and **Chris Gesinski** (#6) won at #2 doubles.
