GARY TAN

Washington & Jefferson College Sophomore - #2 singles/#1 doubles Pittsburgh, Pa./Mt. Lebanon H.S.

Tan won all three of his singles matches and his only doubles match to help W&J improve to a perfect 3-0 on the season, including a 5-4 PAC win over Westminster. The reigning PAC champion at #4 singles and #2 doubles, Tan outpointed his opponents by a combined 30-8 margin in three super-set singles matches.

Also nominated was junior **Ryan Floyd** of Waynesburg and sophomore **Ben Libert** of Westminster.

Bethany opens the 2004 season at home against defending PAC champion Grove City on March 15 at 4 p.m., then travels to Marietta for a non-conference match on Thursday, March 18 at 3 p.m.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson started the 2004 season with three road victories last week ... W&J won four of the five singles matches in the victory over Westminster on Wednesday and used an 8-3 victory by senior **Ehren Frey** and sophomore **Gary Tan** at No. 1 doubles to clinch the win ... Sophomore **Ali Nemazee** and Tan won both of their singles matches on Friday versus Saint Vincent and Davis & Elkins to help W&J improve to 3-0 overall ... Nemazee also teamed with sophomore **Doug Johnston** to win at No. 2 doubles versus Saint Vincent.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City looks for its 14th consecutive Presidents' Athletic Conference title this season ... The Wolverines return only one senior letterwinner, three-time PAC Player of the Year **Patrick Donahue** ... Also back are PAC titlists **Phil Springirth**, **Andrew Geisler**, **Brent Moon** and **Sam Fortna** ... Grove City opens the home portion of the schedule March 24 against Westminster.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg bounced back from a 5-2 loss to La Verne Thursday by defeating Whittier, 6-1, on Friday, as the Jackets went 1-1 for their spring break trip to California ... The Jackets swept doubles over Whittier and won five of the six singles matches in the win ... Junior Ryan Floyd stepped up to the No. 4 spot with his second straight-sets win and raised his singles record to 4-1 ... Freshmen Matt Otis and Jon Crossley evened their records to 3-3 at Nos. 1 and 2 singles, respectively, with wins ... Freshman Bryan McAnulty bounced back from his first defeat of the season at No. 3 to raise his record to 4-1 by posting a win ... Junior Eric Kaluza injured his wrist during the doubles action but completed the match and sat out the singles matches.

Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel men's tennis team opens its 2004 season on Friday when they take on PAC rival Grove City at 3 p.m. in Greenville ... Coming off a 1-11 record and a fifth-place finish at last year's PAC Championships, Thiel returns its top six players from a year ago and sports a freshman class of five going into the season ... Sophomores **Brian Gowday** and **Dennis Wright** enter the season as the Tomcats' top two entries ... Gowday finished third at number one singles at the last season's conference championships ... Wright finished the season 5-6 as the number two singles player.

Westminster Titans

The Titans are winless through three matches in 2004 after dropping 5-4 decisions to John Carroll and PAC rival W&J and an 8-1 loss to Defiance to open the team's spring trip to Hilton Head Island, S.C. ... Juniors Sammy Seo and Dave Molitor posted wins at #4 and #5 singles, respectively, while also teaming for a victory at #2 doubles against John Carroll ... In the PAC opener against the presidents, Westminster was paced by sophomore Ben Libert, the team's lone doublewinner, who captured both the #5 singles slot and #3 doubles with senior brother John Libert ... The lone winner against Defiance was the #3 doubles team of junior Mark Gross and sophomore Ryan Mistovich.
