The Presidents opened their PAC schedule on Thursday afternoon by defeating Waynesburg, 7-2, in Washington, Pa. ... W&J claimed five of the six singles matches and two of the three doubles contests ... Juniors **Matt Dubow** and **Shahin Nemazee** and sophomore **Ehren Frey** all claimed victories in both of their matches in the win ... Dubow picked up a 6-3, 6-1, victory at the No. 5 singles position and then teamed with Frey to collect an 8-5 win at No. 2 doubles ... Nemazee won 6-2, 6-2 at No. 6 singles and teamed with **Francis Burt** to claim their No. 3 doubles match, 8-1 ... Frey also won at No. 4 singles 6-1, 6-1.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg dropped a pair of matches last week, falling to PAC rival Washington & Jefferson 7-2 and at Penn State-Altoona 8-1 ... Freshman **Eric Kaluza** raised his overall record this week to 3-1 at first singles, and 2-2 at first doubles by defeating **Francis Burt** at Washington & Jefferson, after teaming with Ross Josephs for an 8-6 win over the reigning conference champions at first doubles ... His lone loss came at the hands of **David Bruno**, Penn State-Altoona, the AMAC pre-season favorite.

Westminster Titans

The Westminster men's tennis team went 1-2 last week on the team's Spring Break trip to Hilton Head Island, S.C., as the Titan netters swept Heidelberg 9-0 while falling to Salve Regina (0-9) and Green Mountain (3-6) ...
