Bianco posted a pair of victories for the Tomcats, who opened PAC play with a 6-3 road victory at Thomas More. He posted a 6-1, 6-2 decision at third singles over Justin Egan and teamed with freshman Tyler Ochs for an 8-1 win over Egan and Ryan Thompson at second doubles.

Also nominated was junior **John McLane** of Bethany, freshman **John Moyer** of Grove City, junior **Michael Selm** of Thomas More, junior **Bryan McAnulty** of Waynesburg, and freshman **Stefan Hadricky** of Westminster.

Bethany Bison

Bethany opened the year with a 6-3 victory over Pitt-Greensburg ... John McLane, Brian Cerullo and Jason Brun all won twice to pace the victory ... McLane teamed with Tyler Kowcheck for a 9-8 (7-0) victory at #1 doubles, while

Cerullo and Brun picked up an 8-4 triumph at #2 doubles ... In singles, McLane was stretched to three sets but came away with a 5-7, 6-4, (10-8) win at #1 ... Cerullo (6-2, 6-4) and Brun (6-2, 6-1) tallied straight set wins at third and fourth singles respectively to seal the win for first-year Bison head coach **Lisa Keylor** ... In their second match of the week, BC fell 9-0 to 15-time PAC champion Grove City.

Grove City opened the 2006 season with a pair of road matches last week ... At Mount Union Tuesday, the Wolverines dropped a 4-3 decision indoors ... Three freshmen accounted for the Wolverines' wins ... **John**

Moyer won at second singles, while Jeremy Dwyer won at fourth singles and Kyle Johnson earned a three-set win at sixth singles ... Moyer and Brent Moon won at first doubles but Mount Union won second and third doubles to claim the decisive fourth point ... Grove City did not drop a set at Bethany Thursday in the PAC opener ... Johnson, Moon and Moyer were all double-winners ... Freshman Jon Pombo made his collegiate debut at second singles and teamed with Baker for an 8-5 win.
