The Washington & Jefferson men's tennis team lost its second consecutive match to open the 2005 season, falling to Seton Hill, 8-1, Monday afternoon at the Greensburg Racquet Club ... Junior **Doug Johnston** was the only President to pick up a victory on the day as he claimed a 4-6, 6-4, 6-1 victory at No. 5 singles.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City dropped its season opener to Mount Union Tuesday, 5-4, but rebounded with three straight wins to close the week ... The Wolverines opened PAC play Thursday with a 9-0 sweep at Bethany ... Grove City then played a pair of matches in Hilton Head, S.C. Saturday, earning two wins ... Junior **Brent Moon** went 8-0 overall last week ... Moon went 4-0 at first singles and teamed with sophomore **Brock Thompson** for four victories at first doubles ... Freshman Chris Baker went 4-0 at third singles and combined with senior Phil Springirth for a 3-1 mark at second doubles ... Grove City plays Nazareth, St. Mary's (Minn.) and Wooster this week in Hilton Head ... The outdoor home opener is set for April 1 against Frostburg State.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

The Yellow Jackets earned their first match sweep of the spring season when they defeated OAC opponent Marietta College, 7-0, on Saturday ... Waynesburg swept the three doubles match to earn the doubles game before posting six singles victories ... Sophomores Matt Otis and Bryan McAnulty posted an 8-2 victory at No. 1 doubles before earning straight set victories in singles action at No. 1 and No. 2, respectively ... Seniors Mark Gates, Ryan Floyd and Nate Smucker each posted multiple wins against the Pioneers ... Gates teamed with classmate Adam Fuoss for an 8-2 victory at No. 2 doubles before winning his singles match in straight sets ... Floyd and Smucker won at No. 3 doubles by default and Floyd won at No. 5 singles when he defeated **Shawn** Kreiner (6-1, 6-1).

The Tomcats opened up its 2005 season Wednesday with a 6-3 loss to Westminster at the North Beaver Tennis Center ...
