The Bison began the 2004 season with two losses last week, getting swept by both Grove City (9-0) in PAC action on March 15, then at Marietta (7-0) on March 18 ... The Bison will try to rebound this week at Thiel on Tuesday and at Hiram on Thursday ... Both matches will begin at 3 p.m.

Wash. & Jeff. Presidents

Washington & Jefferson ran its overall record to 4-0 on Wednesday after posting a 7-2 victory at Pitt-Greensburg ... The Presidents captured all seven contested matches and forfeited at No. 6 singles and No. 3 doubles ... Sophomores **Gary Tan** and **Ali Nemazee** both stayed undefeated in singles play on the season, while Tan and senior **Ehren Frey** are now both undefeated at No. 1 doubles ... W&J hosts Waynesburg in its first match in Washington on March 30th.

Grove City Wolverines

Grove City opened the 2004 season with a pair of victories on the road last week ... Against Bethany, Grove City did not drop a set in picking up the conference victory ... **Patrick Donahue**, **Sam Fortna**, **Andrew Geisler**, **Brent Moon**, **Phil Springirth** and **Brock Thompson** all earned two victories against the Bison ... At Mount Union, Donahue and Moon were Grove City's only double-winners ... The Wolverines have four matches scheduled in a six-day span this week, including a rescheduled match at Thiel Monday afternoon, weather permitting.

Waynesburg Yellow Jackets

Waynesburg extended its win streak to three matches with road wins over Pitt-Greensburg (9-0) Tuesday and a 7-2 win over Seton Hill Thursday ... The streak is the team's longest in two years ... In the last three matches, the Jackets boast a 17-1 singles record and a 6-3 doubles mark ... Freshman No. 1 singles player **Matt Otis** improved his season record to 5-3 with a pair of straight-sets wins ... He lost his first game in three matches against Seton Hill, but went on to win, 6-1, 6-0 ... Like Otis, No. 2 **Jon Crossley** improved his season singles record to 5-3 with a pair of wins during the week ... Freshman **Bryan McAnulty** and junior **Ryan Floyd** also went 2-0 in singles play during the week to improve their team-high singles records to 6-1 on the year.

Thiel Tomcats

The Tomcat men's tennis team will try to begin its 2004 season this Monday, hosting PAC rival Grove City College at 4 p.m. ... Thiel is set to take on Bethany College Tuesday afternoon (3 p.m.) before two non-conference road contests at Seton Hill on Wednesday (1 p.m.) and at Pitt-Greensburg on Thursday (3 p.m.) ... Thiel was scheduled to open its season on March 19 against Grove City on March 19, but due to inclement weather that match has been pushed back to the 22nd.

Westminster Titans

Westminster went 1-3 in Hilton Head Island, S.C., last week, as the Titans earned their first win with a 6-3 victory over Western New England ... Sophomore **Ben Libert** captured matches at #5 singles and at #3 doubles with classmate **Chris Gesinski** in a 6-3 loss to FDU-Florham ... The lone victory for Westminster in an 8-1 loss to Concordia came from the #2 doubles team of juniors **Sam Seo** and **Dave Molitor** ... A pair of Titans were double winners in a 5-4 loss to Stevens Tech: Molitor captured #4 singles while teaming with Seo at #2 doubles, while Ben Libert captured both #5 singles and #3 doubles with senior brother **John Libert** ... The Libert brothers and Seo were all double winners in the Western New England win.
