Thiel Tomcats

The Thiel men's tennis team got off to a rough start, losing its first four matches of the season last week ... After losing 9-0 to PAC rival Grove City on March 17, the Tomcats fell to Baldwin-Wallace 7-0 in Berea on March 18 ... Freshmen **Den-nis Wright** and **Brian Gowday** each picked up wins against Westminster on March 20 ... Wright defeated **John Libert** 10-3 at #1, while Gowday beat **Mark Gross** 10-5 at #2 ... Thiel took three singles matches against Hiram but came up short in doubles play and fell to the Terriers 4-3 on March 22 ... Wright and Gowday both improved to 2-2 on the season with victories, while sophomore **Randy Keller** earned a 6-3, 6-4 victory at #3 singles.

Westminster Titans

Westminster swept a pair of matches last week, topping Thiel 7-2 in the PAC opener for both schools before posting an 8-1 non-conference at Pitt-Greensburg ...
